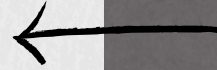

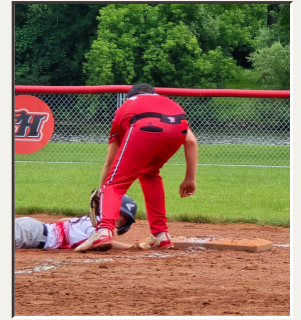
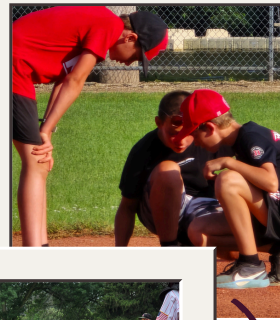
MEMORIAL WEEKEND SHOOTOUT TOURNAMENT UPDATE!
