

MVCYB Policy Guidelines

Registration

All players must be registered to practice, play games, or participate in any other way. Registration fees must be paid to guarantee placement on a team. No player whose registration fee remains unpaid will be given priority over another player whose registration fee has been paid. Registration fee payment provides a base level of funds necessary to operate the league but does not cover the entire cost of the league's operations. The player registration fee is the only fee to be paid directly for participation in the regular MVCYB season. Players that play on a Diamond Dog or Riverdog team will pay an additional fee after those teams are organized.

Eligibility

All children age 6 - 12 who reside within the geographical boundaries of Mount Vernon Conway Youth Baseball shall be eligible to register and play on a MVCYB league baseball team. Any player that registers from an area outside the MVCYB boundaries that does not have a Cal Ripken charter will need to submit a request for approval by the MVCYB board. Exceptions may be made by the board on a case-by-case basis, but exceptions are not guaranteed and should not be assumed to be approved by the board unless the applicant receives written communication from the board specifically approving that request.

Rostering

League teams: Players will be registered in the division based on the player age on April 30th of that season's calendar year. See Division Age Breakdown page for more details.

Requests will be considered but not guaranteed.

Refunds

A full refund minus a \$50 non-refundable fee is available on request on or before February 28, 2021.

A 50% refund minus a \$50 non-refundable fee is available on request between March 1, 2021 and the first game of the league season.

No refunds will be made for any reason whatsoever after the date of the first regular season game.
