



CSC Rink Protocols/COVID-19

- All skaters, coaches, and non-skaters must wash (sanitize) hands before entering the rink.
- While off-ice you must maintain a 6' social distance and wear a mask.
- Anyone entering the Club must conduct a self-assessment and may not enter if they are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 or have been exposed to COVID-19.
- Coaches/Referees/Spectators must sign-in with full contact info upon entry to verify that are symptom free – This will allow us to maintain capacity limits and provide contact tracing if necessary.
- Teams are responsible to hand in game rosters at the end of the game to the Rink Program Director (either in person or slide under office door.)
- The CSC Activity Waiver must be signed and on file prior to participation in on-ice activities (Coaches/Refs/Players on all teams).

Additional guidelines:

- All Skaters should be dressed as much as possible when entering. One parent may help a skater get ready.
- Locker rooms are only available if there is a SafeSport certified locker room monitor for each team.
- Locker rooms must remain clean and skaters must wear masks and maintain social distancing as much as possible while in the locker room.
- Locker rooms must be clean and vacated promptly (within 15 minutes) at the end of the game.
- **ONE SPECTATOR** per player is permitted. On Saturday or Sunday mornings, spectators may use either the small bleacher area or the viewing balcony. All other times, spectators are limited to the bleacher area or the Tartan Lounge (the Zamboni end of the rink). An effort will be made to livestream games.
- All warmups must be done outside of the rink.
- Please do not enter rink more than 10 minutes prior to your scheduled ice time.
- Personal water bottles may not be refilled in the rink.
- All parties must wear face coverings/masks when entering and exiting the rink.
- Coaches and spectators should wear a mask or face covering at all times.
- Referees may use the Men's locker room available to members.
- There is no Lost and Found available; any items left will be discarded.

All groups are required to run games using the guidelines for safety and social distancing set forth by the State of Ohio and USA Hockey.
