

Waterbury:

The main entrance will be split into 2 sides. The 2 right doors will be entrance 1, and the 2 left doors will be entrance 2, and they will be separated with a clear protective barrier.

The doors will be updated daily to show which group will be entering which door.

When you arrive, it is asked that you come mostly dressed, if not fully, as you will not be able to enter the rink until 15 minutes prior to your start time. You will also have to wear a mask coming in. You will go through the doors at which point we may or may not be doing temp checks. Each group should have a "leader" who will have to provide the ice center with waivers from all the participants, and will have to provide the rink with an updated list daily to show who is here for contact tracing purposes. Once you enter through the right doors you will be instructed to follow towards your designated changing area which will have chairs to sit in. You will enter onto the ice by the designated door. Once your scheduled time is up, you are asked to grab your water bottle and gear, and exit the ice as timely as possible, and put your mask back on. At that point you then have 15 minutes to exit the building while the zamboni is on the ice.

At this time the second group (if scheduled) will be entering through the left hand doors and proceeding to their alternate designated changing area, following the same protocols.

That way, when the zamboni is done, the second group can get right on, and the first group should be out the door, and our staff will then clean and sanitize the entire area where the first group was. We will continue to alternate and clean as the day goes on.

Locker rooms will be locked and unavailable for now, as will showers. The water fountain will also be unavailable, and it's advised to bring your own water and make sure you leave with your bottle. We will only have 1 bathroom available, so also advised to go to the bathroom prior to being in the rink, but if you need to use it, it will be open but we can only allow 1 person in at a time.

As of right now there are no parents or spectators allowed, and the snackbar will also remain closed.

The only exception is if any children need help from parents to tie skates, etc - the parents can walk in quickly, help their child, but are then asked to leave.

I think that about sums it up - let me know if you have any particular questions. For the month of September we are maintaining the 30 minute gap between skates to allow all of you to get used to the protocols, and allow our staff to become efficient at the cleaning procedure. By October we plan to be running at full capacity with the traditional 15min down time for the zamboni. I know this is a royal pain in the badonkadonk, but just remember that these are the protocols that the rink must follow in order to open, and stay open. People violating these procedures will not be allowed in the rink, or worse, could cause the rink to be shut back down - so please do your best with the situation, let's all be respectful and have some fun getting back on the ice!!

Also, if anyone has any suggestions or comments about the rink after we reopen and get going, please send them my way. Being new I am very open to ideas and ways to improve the rink, not to mention with the floor issue we had, we will have to run our coolant system differently and I want to make sure everyone has great ice to skate on (not too warm not too cold) - so again, feel free to shoot me comments or suggestions if you feel there should be any changes made!

GUIDELINES FOR ENTERING RINK as of 6.1.20

- You may NOT enter if you have any respiratory illness symptoms
 - Facial covering MUST be worn at ALL times (except on the ice)
 - 6 feet social distancing must be adhered to at all times
 - Mandatory paperwork needs to be completed before entering the rink
 - Mandatory temperature checks before entering the rink
 - Maximum of 25 skaters allowed into the rink at 1 time
 - All skaters must come dressed as locker rooms are NOT available
 - Chairs will be provided 6 ft apart to put skates on at rinkside
 - Only 1 person at a time allowed into the designated bathrooms
 - Locker rooms / Showers are NOT available at this time
 - All skaters may only arrive 15 mins before & must vacate the premises 15 mins after scheduled ice time
 - No spectators allowed at this time ~ if a parent needs to help their child with gear/skates, they may do so after form & temperature check is done but may not stay in the rink
 - Skate sharpenings by appointment only
- *** Effective 6.18.20*****
- Rink 1 Entryway for Rink 1 Skaters ONLY
 - Rink 2 skaters MUST enter thru Side Door (Official's Room) in Rink 2

***** Effective 7.3.20*****

- Out of State skaters allowed with PRIOR approval by Rink Management

Cairns Arena As of 9-1-2020

GUIDELINES FOR ENTERING RINK as of 9.1.20

- You may NOT enter if you have any respiratory illness symptoms
- Facial covering MUST be worn at ALL times (except on the ice)
- 6 feet social distancing must be adhered to at all times
- Out of State skaters MUST have PRIOR approval by Rink Management
- **Maximum of 30 skaters allowed into the rink at 1 time**
- **All skaters may only arrive 10 mins before (so please come dressed) & MUST leave the rink 15 mins after scheduled ice time**
- **We ask that Contact Tracing forms are completed beforehand as it expedites the check-in process**
- Mandatory temperature checks before entering the rink
- Rink 1 Entryway for Rink 1 Skaters ONLY & Rink 2 skaters MUST enter thru Side Door (Official's Room) in Rink 2
- All skaters must come dressed as locker rooms are NOT available
- Chairs will be provided 6 ft apart to put skates on at rinkside
- Only 1 person at a time allowed into the designated bathrooms
- Locker rooms / Showers are NOT available at this time
- No spectators allowed at this time ~ if a parent needs to help their child with gear/skates, they may do so after form & temperature check is done but may not stay in the rink
- Skate sharpenings by appointment only


Guidelines to Enter Stowe Arena

Last updated 6/22/2020

Upon Entering



Facial coverings MUST be worn at all times (except on the ice)



6 feet **social distancing** must be adhered to at all times (except on the ice)



Visitors must be **VT residents or meet the 14 day-quarantine** requirement



Mandatory health screening needs to be completed before entering arena



No entry will be permitted if you have any symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, fever > 100.4, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell)

Limited Services

25 skaters allowed on a full sheet of ice. If the ice is divided by dividers then 25 skaters per half but they cannot interact with other group.

Locker rooms and shower are NOT available at this time

Skaters may dress in the lobby and community room

Chairs and benches will be available with 6 feet distance

Public bathrooms will be available



Additional Information

All skaters must vacate the Arena **15 minutes after scheduled ice time**

NO SPECTATORS allowed at this time

Skate sharpenings by **appointment only**

NO Public Skate or Stick Time at this time
