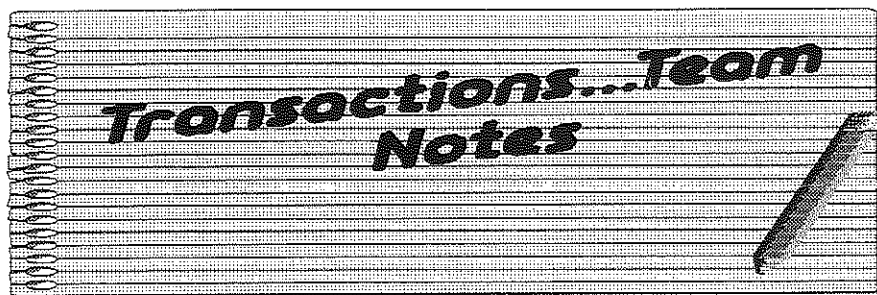
GAME SUMMARIES...CONTINUED
