Committee Reports

1. Tournaments (BEM Report via JC)
 - a. State Tourney Championship Weekend - Stowe 2017, SASA 2018, looking for bids for 2019
 - b. Working with local organizations to match team names for state site linking and getting appropriate people access to the appropriate pages on the state site. See powerpoint for tutorial on adding games and scores.
 - c. As standings and brackets fall in, the hope is to set the schedule for playdown weekends by the end of December
 - d. Apparel options for state tournament – two local vendors to produce goods up front, look into bringing a vendor to each site, each weekend for onsite screen-printing – updates next mtg
2. Rules & Hockey Development (RSP Report (+NI input))
 - a. Player Devo Tryouts – registration link on VT site
 - i. Boys '00, '01, '02 – 10/2 & 10/16 at Cairns – so far going well, new software for check-in and evaluations well received, registration numbers are down from last year approx. 33% across all birth years
 - ii. Girls '00, '01, '02, '03 – 10/23 at Hookset – run by the district and pre-registration required
 - iii. Boys '03, '04, '05 & Girls '04, '05 – considering a weekend long player development festival April 1 & 2. Please share/save these dates and notify spring/summer programs to help avoid conflict. Hockey Development Committee will help with more planning this winter.
 - b. Transfer Requests need to be completed ASAP for anyone who played elsewhere for the 2015-16 season. 65 submissions as of 10/8, 27 of those were local association to local association transfers
 - c. NI to meet with sportengine in Minneapolis on 10/14. Need organizations to complete credit card processing survey in order to reduce everyone's fees. 4 associations took advantage of SE Support Nights – CSB, BAHA, Lyndon & Harwood. NI available to help troubleshoot sportengine.
 - d. Attendance Policy continues to be discussed, including a proposal from MIDD (Boothe H), a proposed policy to be presented prior to November meeting for discussion
 - e. Quick change goalie gear backordered – hope to arrive by December
 - f. The state is reinforcing the importance of locker room policies/safesport. Good supervision is key (referenced recent hazing incident at UVM)
 - g. BG – Registration update – has only received 19 rosters, background checks required every two years, link on state site and cleared volunteers are now listed as well
 - h. JC – Free Equipment event at Barre in early October was successful. State has acquired significant equipment to help stock the “try hockey trailer”. CaW is looking into insurance and acquisition of trailer
 - i. CrW – kudos to coaches for attending CEP clinics, level 3 at Stowe 10/16; level ?? at Woodstock 11/??; level 2 at Northfield 11/20; level 3 at Middlebury 12/4; May add another level 1 in December
 - j. CrW – hoping to do some ADM regional clinics for associations that want to host
 - k. BC – RIC for the past 23+ years – successful 1st clinic early October (61 L1, 19 L2, 39 L3) – upcoming clinics L1-4 at Hartford 10/22; L1-3 in Rutland 11/16. No rule changes this year.
 - l. JC/MH – currently going through audit with USA Hockey (every 3 years)

- m. DS – Hoping to have some sled hockey clinics at Norwich & Middlebury this year, more info on state website. New sled hockey team in Lyndon area (Exec Dir Sandy at meeting, adaptive sports partner – North Country Sled Dogs), over 130 volunteers and 185 folks with disabilities, hoping to grow interest.
3. Marketing (JC Report)
- a. Grant requests on website under Resources/Forms - \$11k given from USA Hockey for growth. Submit proposals, get creative then save receipts and keep paper trail.
 - b. Continuing to work on Hockey wide event – timing TBD
 - c. Sign up for Club Excellence and report back to the state any comments/issues
 - d. Share local growth events with state via email or social media so they can help advertise and share with partners
 - e. Will pass around amended bylaws for everyone’s approval

President's Report

*JC requests approval November minutes –NI 1st, MEMBER 2nd

*JC – all minutes posted on website, no updates from NED

- NI and JC on the road going to local board meetings, make sure those meetings are posted on local websites
- Upper Valley/Hartford have no teams registered in VT this year (Lebanon and Hartford merged 5+ years ago and are based this season in NH), they will be allied members for this season

Committee Reports

1. Tournaments (BEM Report)

- a. Watching game entries – about 5% missing from beginning of season
- b. BAHA, Barre, CVSA, Essex, Lyndon, Northshire, Rutland, St. Albans, Woodstock – Home teams missing game entries on state site
- c. Until 12/31 can withdraw from state tourney without penalty, but if your team is CONSIDERING withdrawing please let BEM know ASAP for planning playdown weekend hosts

2. Rules & Hockey Development

- a. Player Devo Tryouts – registration link on VT site (JC led committee group)
 - i. Boys & Girls '04, '05 – a weekend long player development festival April 1 & 2. Share/save dates and help avoid conflict. Hockey Development Committee will help with more planning in January. Looking for 50+ girls, 75+ boys
 - ii. PLANNING IDEAS:
 1. Invite numbers based on organization population %, Perhaps Stars/Glades at large
 2. Advertise ahead of time, be prepared and organized, have coaches and schedule already set on launch
 3. Off ice (kids and parents) – dryland, guest speakers, training, nutrition, peer to peer
 4. Get the right coaches, possibly provide certification clinic at the same time
 5. Be able to provide feedback to athletes after the event and summer options
 6. How do we draw families to the area? Hotel blocks? Movie night/evening activity?
 - iii. Future – plan holiday week camps to help development at all different levels of kids
- b. Rules (led by NI)
 - i. Recommendations of changes to transfer policies and combined teams
 - ii. Will review this month and bring back proposed revisions next month
 - iii. NI and RSP working with local organizations on some disciplinary items
 - iv. New attendance policy – NI received an appeal from Northshire to relieve them of said commitment (see attached)
 1. CSB made a motion to allow Northshire to relieve them of attendance policy commitment, Northshire 2nd
 - a. YES – (5)
 - b. NO – (11)
 - c. APPEAL DENIED
- c. Rosters/Registrar (led by BG)
 - i. 20 coaches still redlined due to missing background check and just a few for safesport
 - ii. Have heard that there are also coaches on the bench and ice that aren't on rosters at all
 1. Puts local and state in a tough/liable situation if anything were to happen
 - iii. There is a parent safesport module for volunteers – it is recommended as they are best suited to recognize behaviors that would be concerning

- iv. (BG) Following rules sent down from USA and NED and takes these credentials very seriously
 - v. Stewardship responsibility by local registrars to follow guidelines
 - vi. On 1/1/17 will check to make sure ALL coaches have met coaching online module requirements
 - vii. State MAY put USA approved rosters on the state website TBD
 - viii. Tournament Committee would have the ability to not count games if rostered coaches were not approved yet (only 6 or 7 teams had NO eligible coaches to start the season – that has since been resolved)
 - ix. National bound rosters - will be checking credential books and birth certificates prior to FEBRUARY 7th meeting for the following groups
 - 1. 14U Boys & Girls - Tier I & Tier II
 - 2. 16U Girls - Tier II
 - 3. 19U Girls - Tier I & Tier II
 - x. REMINDER – must get a travel permit for any/all teams playing in Canada
- d. Rules/Reffing (led by BC)
- i. Concerned about the LACK of majors/misconduct reporting
 - ii. Anything above a minor, MUST complete an incident report form; charging, boarding, checking from behind, contact to the head – all should have minor +
 - iii. A team with 15 penalties means penalty to a coach and should also result in incident report
 - iv. Will send reminders to all refs
- e. Pop up year-round teams at 14U level (led by JC)
- i. Glades have been the VT Tier I rep; new(er) declarations by Flames (1 team), Dynamo (1 team), Wildcats (14U and below)
 - ii. VSAHA is proactively “dealing with it”, had some good conversations and meetings, nothing official and will share progress, want what’s best for all Vermont kids

Article I. Name, Office, Duration and Purpose.

1.01. Name.

The name of this association is Vermont State Amateur Hockey Association and hereinafter shall be designated VSAHA.

1.02. Principal Office.

The principal office of the association shall be located and resides at the VSAHA ~~Registrars-Treasurer's~~ physical address or wherever the Board of Directors of the Association shall from time to time designate the location of the principal office.

1.03. Duration.

The duration of existence of this association shall be perpetual.

1.04. Purpose.

The purpose of this association shall be guided by the Core Values of USA Hockey. VSAHA and its Board of Directors are responsible for developing and implementing those action plans and activities that best meet the spirit of the following USA Hockey Core Values.

- **Sportsmanship:** Foremost of all values is to learn a sense of fair play. Become humble in victory, gracious in defeat. We will foster friendship with teammates and opponents alike.
- **Respect for the individual:** Treat all others as you expect to be treated.
- **Integrity:** We seek to foster honesty and fair play beyond more strict interpretation of the rules and regulations of the game.
- **Pursuit of Excellence at the Individual, Team, and Organizational Levels:** Each member of the organization, whether player, volunteer, or staff, should seek to perform each aspect of the game to the highest level of his or her ability.
- **Enjoyment:** It is important for the hockey experience to be fun, satisfying, and rewarding for the participant.
- **Loyalty:** We apprise to teach loyalty to the ideals of fellow members of the sport of hockey.
- **Teamwork:** We value the strength of learning together. The use of teamwork is reinforced and rewarded by success in the hockey experience.

1.05. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall be a Vermont not for profit corporation, operating as provided in its Articles of Association as filed with the Vermont Secretary of State, intended to be an Affiliate Association of USA Hockey, Inc, and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

1.06. USA Hockey Preeminence.

The VSAHA, an Affiliate Association of USA, Hockey, Inc., shall abide by and in accord with the Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, Playing Rules and decisions of the Board of Directors of USA Hockey, and such documents shall take precedence over and supersede all similar governing documents and/or decisions of VSAHA. Further, the VSAHA (i) shall assist USA Hockey in the administration and enforcement of the provisions of the By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, Playing Rules and decisions of the Board of Directors of USA Hockey, Inc., within and upon its members and/or within its jurisdiction and (ii) agrees to be guided by the Core Values of USA Hockey.

1.07. Indemnity.

The VSAHA, an Affiliate Association of USA Hockey, Inc., shall indemnify and hold harmless USA Hockey, the Board of directors of USA Hockey and each member thereof, the Executive Committee of USA Hockey, and each member thereof, councils and committees of USA Hockey and each member thereof, and all other elected, appointed, employed or volunteer representatives of USA Hockey from any and all claims, liability, judgments, costs, attorneys' fees, charges and expenses whatsoever, arising from the acts and omissions of VSAHA, except to the extent (i) that USA Hockey or its afore described representatives caused such claims, liability, judgments, costs, attorneys' fees, charges or expenses by their own intentional neglect or default or (ii) that such acts or omissions were the direct result of compliance with the Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, Playing Rules or decisions of the Board of Directors of USA hockey. Further, the VSAHA understands and acknowledges that USA Hockey and its afordescribed representatives have assumed such assignment, function, office or capacity upon the express understanding, agreement and condition that they be so indemnified and held harmless to the extent described in this by-law. USA Hockey shall reasonably cooperate with Affiliate in any litigation and provide reasonable support in connection therewith, including but not limited to advise and testimony upon reasonable request; provided, however, that such cooperation shall not require USA Hockey to incur any out of pocket expense not reimbursed by Affiliate.

Article II. Members.

2.01. Membership.

The members of the association shall be composed of the VSAHA Local Association Members and Allied Members to whom membership has been bestowed by the board of directors.

2.02. Local Association.

Is any association within Vermont, representing a specified geographic area approved and designated by VSAHA which:

- a) Has one or more USA Hockey registered team members, and
- b) operates a program of skill development, practice or competition or a combination of such, in house or with other Local Associations or registered team members, and
- c) functions throughout the regular winter season, and
- d) has an approved signed Affiliate Agreement with VSAHA

Local Association Members shall be the medium through which Registered Team Members shall carry out the purposes of VSAHA, including, subject to USA Hockey requirements, the functions of Membership acceptance and discontinuance, Playing Rules, Discipline, State Tournament play leading to Regional and National Tournament play, ~~player development~~ All-Star tryouts and play, Financial and Organizational duties and the exercise of all other powers and duties granted by Vermont law, USA Hockey, these Bylaws or the Rules, Regulations and Policies duly enacted by VSAHA.

2.03. Allied Membership

Any individual, organization or entity, ~~having an amateur ice hockey team registered with USA Hockey,~~ ~~but~~ which does not qualify as a Local Association Member, shall be deemed an "Allied Member". Membership needs to be approved by the VSAHA Executive Board for individual teams, and the full VSAHA Board of Directors for organizations with more than one team. VSAHA Executive Board will establish a process for requesting membership. If approved, and as such teams/organizations shall be entitled access to the benefits and programs of USA Hockey as a member of VSAHA, and shall be subject to the playing rules and regulations of USA Hockey as enforced by VSAHA, but shall not be entitled to

Attendance by VSAHA members at meetings will be governed by the "VSAHA Meeting Attendance Policy". VSAHA can levy sanctions or fines for non-compliance of the attendance policy by member organizations.

Article III. Organization – Officers and Agents.

3.01. Board of Directors, Officer Directors, Appointees.

- a) The Association shall have: (1) a President; (2) First Vice President, (3) Second Vice President, (4) a Treasurer; (5) a Secretary, and such other officers and assistant officers and agents as the Board of Directors may think necessary.
- b) Officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors immediately preceding the expiration of an officer's term or whenever a vacancy exists. Officers may be elected by the Board to fill a vacancy at any meeting, whether regular or special.
- c) Unless otherwise specified by the Board at the time of his or her election or appointment, each officer's term shall end on the last day of the Association's annual year. Each officer shall serve until the end of his or her term, or if earlier, his or her death, resignation, or removal.
- d) No two offices may be held by the same person, except in an emergency situation. Any such situation must be promptly disclosed to the membership.
- e) Newly elected officers shall assume their respective offices upon the expiration of the officers' terms to which they were elected to succeed.

3.02. Officers.

- a) **President:** The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board. The Treasurer shall make an annual financial report to Executive Director of USA Hockey, Inc. The Treasurer shall make such other financial reports and shall file such tax returns as shall be required by law. The Treasurer shall have the authority to sign all checks written by the Association.
- e) ~~Secretary:~~ **Secretary:** The Secretary shall keep all records, and be charged with the mailing of all meeting notices and the recording and keeping all minutes, as well as any correspondence required by the Executive Board and the Board. The Secretary will be responsible for filing any and all documents

248 status of the association. \

249 **3.03. Directors.**

250 The business and affairs of the Association shall be managed by the Board of Directors who may exercise
251 all such powers of the Association and perform all such lawful acts and things as are not (by Statute)
252 directed or required to be exercised or done by the member The Board of Directors shall be constituted
253 as follows;

254 a) **Local Association Directors** - Each Local Association shall be entitled to one seat on
255 the Board of Directors and to one vote upon all matters before the Board. This Director
256 will be elected by the Association's players as provided herein or appointed by the local
257 officers elected by the Association's players as provided herein.

258
259 b) **Officer Directors** - Each person holding an elected Office in VSAHA shall be a director
260 entitled to one vote upon all matters before the Board.

261
262 c) **USA Hockey Appointees** - Each person appointed to the position of Registrar, Referee
263 in Chief, and Coaching Director by USA Hockey, or other position as required by USA
264 hockey. USA Hockey appointees shall not be entitled to vote.

265 e)d) **VSAHA Appointees:** Each person appointed to the position of Grow the Game
266 Coordinator, Girls/Women's Director, Disabled Hockey Coordinator, VPA Coordinator, and
267 Goalie Coordinator or other position(s) as required. VSAHA appointees shall not be
268 entitled to vote

269 270 **3.04. Appointed Positions.**

271 The VSAHA Officer Directors have the authority to appoint new roles to serve on the VSAHA Board with
272 specific duties to address areas of hockey in Vermont. The positions and their duties will be outlined in
273 the VSAHA Annual Guide. USA Hockey may request specific functional roles; VSAHA may require that
274 these roles be served by an appointed position. Appointed positions will be members of the Executive
275 Board. Appointed positions shall not be entitled to vote.

276 277 **3.05. Executive Board.**

278 Each officer, together with the officers appointed by USA Hockey and the VSAHA appointed positions,
279 shall constitute an Executive Board charged with the responsibility of organizing Board business,
280 presenting the business to the full Board. Ex Officio Executive Board members may be elected to the
281 Executive Board by the Executive Board, with the consent of a majority vote of a quorum of the
282 membership, to serve on the Executive Board, without vote and in an advisory capacity only.

283 **3.06. Nomination and Election of Officers.**

284 The President shall appoint a nominating committee at the regular February meeting, which committee
285 shall be charged with presenting a slate of nominations for officers to be presented at the regular March
286 meeting each year, such slate together with nominations from the floor received at the March meeting, to
287 be voted upon at the Annual Meeting.

3.07. Election.

291 Any person having an interest in youth ice hockey in the State of Vermont, duly nominated by the
292 nominated committee or by nomination duly seconded from the floor at the meeting designated for
293 nominations, shall, upon receiving a majority vote of the Directors present at the vote, shall be elected to
294 the office for which such person was nominated for the following term lengths:

295

President: One (1) year

296

First Vice-President: One (1) year

297

Second Vice-President: One (1) year

298

Secretary: Two (2) years commencing and terminating in odd-numbered years

299

Treasurer: Two (2) years commencing and terminating in even-numbered years

300

301

3.08. Removal.

303 Any officer may be removed from the office upon a 2/3rds vote of the membership at any regular
304 meeting provided at least 10 days written notice of the proposed action has been given to each Board
305 Member.

3.09. Resignations.

307 An officer or agent may resign by giving written notice to the President or Secretary. The resignation
308 shall take effect at the time specified in it, or immediately, if no time is specified. Unless it specifies
309 otherwise, a resignation takes effect without being accepted.

310

3.10. Vacancies.

312 Any vacancy occurring in any office shall be filled by appointment of the President, approved by the
313 Board, for the remaining term. Any vacancy occurring in the office of President shall be filled by the First
314 Vice President, in which case the Second Vice President shall become the First Vice President and a new
315 Second Vice President shall be appointed.

3.11. Committees.

317 The VSAHA shall have the following committees;

318

a) **Executive Committee:** The Executive Committee shall be empowered to conduct routine
319 business of the association, coordinate the work and presentations of all committees and to serve
320 in an advisory capacity to the President and the Board of Directors. The executive committee will
321 include the President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and other
322 members of the Board of Directors as the President may deem necessary.

323

b) **Nominating Committee:** The Nominating Committee shall be comprised of three (3) current
324 directors. The Committee and Committee Chair shall be appointed by the President of the
325 Association Board of Directors at the regular February meeting. The committee shall be charged
326 with presenting a slate of nominations for officers to be presented at the regular March meeting
327 each year, such slate together with nominations from the floor received at the March meeting, to
328 be voted upon at the Annual Meeting.

c) **Rules Committee:** The Rules Committee shall be chaired by the ~~Second-First~~ Vice President and
330 shall consist of two or more additional persons elected by majority vote at the Regular October
331 meeting. This committee shall function as a judicial body in all matters pertaining to playing
332 rules, disciplinary actions, procedures and participation in hockey programs sponsored by VSAHA.
333 All requests for hearing must be presented to the Rules Committee Chair within ten (10) days of
334 the occurrence of any matter properly before the Committee or of actual or construction notice
335 thereof. The Rules Committee shall defer jurisdiction to the ~~Members Local~~ Association or may
336 take original jurisdiction of any matter which it feels is not being handled in an appropriate or
337 timely manner. Appeals from ~~Members Local~~ Association decisions shall be made to the Chair of

- 338 the Rules Committee, in writing, not more than ten (10) calendar days from the date of the
339 rendering of the decision.
- 340 d) **Tournament Committee:** The Tournament Committee shall be chaired by the ~~First-Second~~
341 Vice President and shall consist of four or more members. This committee shall be responsible for
342 preparing and recommending to the Board matters concerning conduct of the Vermont State
343 Tournaments operated by VSAHA, including format, site selection, team seeding, rules and player
344 and coach eligibility, and for implementing Board directives concerning tournament
345 arrangements.
- 346 e) ~~Select Teams~~**Player Development Committee:** The ~~Player Development-Select Teams~~
347 Committee shall be chaired by the ~~FirstSecond~~ Vice President and will be made up of the
348 Coaching Director for VSAHA, Woman's Director for VSAHA, and a representative(s)-from any
349 Member Association, Allied or otherwise, appointed by the ~~Coaching Director~~VSAHA President.
350 The Committee will develop the overall protocol to be used throughout the Select Team selection
351 process to ensure a fair and equitable process takes place.
- 352 f) **Appointed or Special Committees:** Appointed or Special committees shall be created by
353 resolution of the Board of Directors. Such resolution shall establish the size, term, and task of the
354 committees. The President shall appoint the members of the committees from the membership of
355 the Board of Directors and shall designate a chairperson. Each special committee shall provide
356 interim reports to the Executive Committee as requested by the Executive Committee, shall
357 coordinate its activities with the strategic planning activities of the Executive Committee and
358 report to the Board of Directors annually.

359 **Article IV. Eligibility for State Tournament.**

360 **4.01. Residency Requirements.**

361 Only players who are bona fide residents of the State of Vermont are eligible for State Tournament
362 competition with the following exceptions:

- 363 a) A player residing in a neighboring community in the States of New York, Massachusetts, or New
364 Hampshire who is eligible to register with or to transfer to a Vermont Registered Team Member
365 as a permitted transfer; a Board-approved transfer for extraordinary circumstances; or as part of
366 a combined team.
- 367 b) Players who are residing in the State of Vermont with blood or familial relatives.
- 368 c) Residency is where the player habitually resides. Unless established to the contrary, residency is
369 presumed to be with one of the parents of the player. The Board may consider any relevant
370 factor in determining the place of the player's residency.
- 371 d) A student, residing temporarily in the State of Vermont in a bona fide exchange program may
372 petition the Board for permission to play with a Local Association.

373 **4.02. Select Teams for Age Groups 14U and Younger.**

374 Select teams for age groups 14U and younger, (youth and girls,) are not eligible for State Tournament
375 Competition except: VSAHA may designate one Select Team to compete in a Tier I State Tournament. A
376 team from any Local Association may also compete in a Tier I Tournament if the team so declares before
377 December 31, of that season. If the Select Team is not challenged, that team will represent Vermont in
378 the Tier I Regional Tournament. Any Select Team so designated must comply with the requirements set
379 out in Article IV, Paragraph 4.01 ~~and utilize open tryouts to establish its roster.-~~

380 **4.03. Select Teams for Age Groups 16U and Older.**

381 Select teams for age groups 16U and older, (youth and girls/women,) are permitted in State Tournament
382 competition provided that the team (a) utilizes open tryouts to establish its roster and (b) is composed of
383 players who comply with By-law Article IV, Paragraph 4.01-

384 Article V. Dispute Resolution.

385 5.01. Dispute Resolution Procedures.

386 In order to provide for an efficient, orderly and uniform method of resolving all Disputes, the following
387 Dispute Resolution procedures are hereby adopted.

- 388
- 389 a) ~~MemberLocal~~ **ASSOCIATION:** The preferred decision making body, for all matters shall be
390 the ~~MemberLocal~~ Association. The ~~MemberLocal~~ Association Board of Officers shall constitute the
391 original jurisdiction for all decisions.
- 392 b) **RULES COMMITTEE:** Any party aggrieved by a decision of the ~~MemberLocal~~ Association
393 respecting matters shall appeal such decision to the Rules Committee in writing not more that 10
394 days after receipt of the decision of the ~~Local Organization~~ Member Association. The rules
395 Committee shall hold a de novo hearing within twenty (20) days of receipt of the appeal and
396 render written findings and a decision within ten (10) days of hearing.
- 397 c) **BOARD:** Any party aggrieved by a decision of the Rules Committee may appeal to the full Board
398 by written notice delivered to the Chair of the Rules Committee not less than 24 hours prior to
399 the next regular full board meeting. Such appeal shall specifically address the written findings of
400 the Rules Committee, indicating objections thereto. The Executive Board shall determine whether
401 additional documentary or oral evidence shall be presented to the Board. The Board shall
402 deliberate and announce its decision at the time of the hearing.
- 403 d) **BINDING ARBITRATION:** Action of the Board shall be presented to arbitration conducted by a
404 single arbitrator provided both parties agree, or, if there is no agreement, by a panel of three
405 arbitrators, one each selected by each party and a neutral selected by each of the other
406 arbitrators.

407 Article VI. General Provisions.

408 6.01. Checks and Notes.

409 Checks, demands for money, and notes of the Association shall be signed by officer(s) or other person(s)
410 designated from time to time by the Board of Directors. Any long-term obligation which exceeds the
411 assets of the organization will require the approval of the Executive Board.

412 6.02. Depositories.

413 Designation of banks and financial institutions where funds of the Association are to be deposited or
414 invested, as well as authorization of other investments, shall be a function of the Board of Directors.

415 6.03. Fiscal Year.

416 The fiscal year of the Association shall begin on the first (1st) day of August each year and end the
417 following July thirty-first (31st).

418 6.04. Amendment of Bylaws.

419 These Bylaws may be altered, amended, or repealed at any meeting or special meeting of the Board of
420 Directors by a two thirds (2/3rds) vote of the Board, provided written notice of the proposed amendment
421 has been given at least ten (10) calendar days prior to the meeting by hand delivery, mail or email. It is
422 presumed that notice given at any regular meeting is adequate notice for amendments offered at the
423 next regular meeting.

426 **6.05. Notice.**

427 Whenever, by statute, these Bylaws, or otherwise, notice is required to be given to a member, director,
428 or committee members, and no provision is made as to how the notice shall be given, it shall not be
429 construed to mean personal notice, but any such notice may be given:

- 430 a. In writing, by mail, postage prepaid, by fax, posting on the VSAHA website, or by e-mail,
431 addressed to the director, committee member, or member at the address on the books of the
432 association.
- 433 b. In another method permitted by law. Any notice required or permitted to be given by mail shall
434 be deemed given at the time when the same is thus deposited in the United States mail.

435 **6.06. Insurance.**

436 The Board shall obtain and maintain such insurance as is recommended by USA Hockey or an
437 independent VSAHA insurance advisor, including Directors and Officers Liability Insurance.

438 **6.07. Equal Opportunity.**

439 VSAHA shall provide an equal competitive opportunity taking into account ability, physical size and other
440 athletic criteria, to amateur athletes, coaches, trainers, managers, administrators, and officials to
441 participate, consistent with the requirements of the Amateur Sports Act of 1978, as amended, in amateur
442 athletic competition without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, age, sex, or national
443 origin.

444 **6.08. Table of Contents: Headings.**

445 The table of contents and headings are for organization, convenience and clarity. In interpreting these
446 Bylaws, they shall be subordinated in importance to the other written material.

448 **6.09. Annual Guide.**

449 The VSAHA Annual Guide shall be published on or before September 1 of each year. In the event a new
450 Annual Guide is not published by that date, the Annual Guide from the previous year will remain in effect
451 until the new edition is published. The Annual Guide shall contain the rules, regulations and policies of
452 VSAHA and shall control all matters not specifically covered by these by-laws. Any rules, regulations or
453 policies contained in the Annual Guide may be modified or amended by the Board Of Directors at any
454 regular, annual or special meeting of the Board provided that notice is given to each Director either by
455 hand delivery, mail or email at least 10 days prior to the meeting. The omission of any matter from
456 either ~~the~~ these Bylaws or the Annual Guide shall not preclude the Board from adopting and/or enforcing
457 any rule or policy deemed in the best interests of youth hockey in Vermont.

459 **6.10. Rules of Procedure.**

460 When these Bylaws do not specify procedures to be followed, Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised,
461 shall be used as a guide.

462 **Article VII. Dispersal of Assets.**

463 **7.01. Dissolution of the Corporation.**

464 Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for
465 payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the
466 purpose of the corporation, or so to such organization or organizations organized and operated
467 exclusively for charity, education, religious, or scientific purposes and shall at the time qualify as an
468 exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or
469 corresponding provisions of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, State, or
470 local government for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court
471 of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principle office of the organization is then located,
472 exclusively for such purpose.
