POSITION: *VARSITY HEAD HOCKEY COACH*
AVAILABILITY: *IMMEDIATE*

QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's or advanced degree with teacher's certificate preferred. Previous head coaching experience strongly preferred. The ideal candidate will have a strong history of character and adult staff development. The head hockey coach must realize and appreciate the need for the hockey program to work with other sports as a complement to the entire athletic department, as well as a demonstrated commitment to the ideals of Catholic and Jesuit education. All applicants must have a current resume with a fully completed application as directed below.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1) Ability to be available, organize and supervise practice sessions, off-season workouts, and other activities that pertain to a complete hockey program including, but not limited to coordinating U of D Jesuit out of season activities as directed by the Athletic Department
- 2) Support the school's Athletic Shared Vision, particularly as it pertains to:
a) Athletic Code b) formation c) academic focus d) athletic development
- 3) Provide locker room supervision
- 4) Hire assistant coaches within the guidelines of the U of D Jesuit Assistant Coach hiring procedure as defined by U of D Jesuit High School & Academy
- 5) Attend all mandated U of D Jesuit/League/MHSAA meetings and training sessions
- 6) Responsible for inventory, distribution and collection of uniforms and equipment

EXPECTATIONS:

- 1) Provide U of D Jesuit scholar-athletes with an exceptional hockey experience
- 2) Be open to growth, flexible and emotionally intelligent
- 3) Direct a program with a Jesuit identity of excellence
- 4) Build relationships with students, faculty, media, staff and community
- 5) Support the U of D Jesuit Athletic Department's student-athlete development programs
- 6) Support the school administration on matters involving the hockey program
- 7) Maintain appropriate relationships and boundaries with student/athlete, parents, etc.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Will adhere to policies provided by U of D Jesuit, the Archdiocese of Detroit, and the MHSAA
- 2) Attend/participate in required abuse risk management training as directed by U of D Jesuit High School & Academy
- 3) Adhere to procedures related to managing high-risk activities and supervising students
