



PINNACLE FOOTBALL VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTIONS

STADIUM & FIELD CREW

CHAIN GANG / FIELD CREW

Volunteer needed to work chains or down marker at all Home games. Volunteer needs to be detail oriented, attentive, and able to take direction from the officials

Additional Requirements:

- Ability to always maintain decorum on sidelines.
- Minimal interaction with players and coaches.
- Ability to stand for the entire game (other than half-time)

INFLATABLE HELMET TEAM (Varsity Home Games only)

A team of 4 individuals who set-up the inflatable helmet that players run through before each Varsity Home Game then deflate and remove from field prior to kick-off. It is preferred that volunteers will commit to this position for the entire season. (approx 5 regular season home games + any post season home games).

NORTH/PLAYER-GATE ENTRY MONITOR (*VARSAITY HOME GAMES*)

A proactive volunteer is needed to help PHS monitor the North Gate Entry which provides complimentary access to all Pinnacle football players, same-day game volunteers, immediate family of same-day coaching staff, specifically listed guest(s) of the event, and Pioneer level booster club members. Volunteer must be comfortable denying entry to those who are not on that specific game-day list by providing contact information of a Booster Club member for further discussion.

BROADCAST TEAM

LIVE BROADCAST PRODUCERS (**IDEALLY 2 PER GAME**)

Oversees and manages Pinnacle's Live Broadcast production. Sets up cameras, audio, and broadcast equipment and ensures everything is functioning properly before and during games. Ensures broadcast announcers and camera operators are ready to go before game time. Operates camera switcher from close to wide shots and updates online scoreboard during the game. Maintains the live stream of the event to streaming providers (YouTube, Facebook).

Requirements / Experience: A basic comfort level with PC's is required, along with a mind for connecting and breaking down cables and camera equipment. If this is you, we can teach you the "Producer" role. Several 'on-the-job' training sessions will be provided to get you up-to-speed with setup / breakdown / live streaming.

BROADCAST ASSISTANTS - SET-UP/TEAR DOWN: (ALTERNATIVE TO 2 PRODUCERS)

Assists the Producer with loading equipment in/out, setting up broadcast equipment, cameras, and audio, and helps to ensure everything is functioning properly before game time. Helps to ensure broadcast announcers and camera operators are ready to go before game time.

Once the broadcast equipment is set up, tested, and ready to roll – this person can join family and friends in the stands to watch the game OR assist with the Live Stream. Your choice!

Requirements: Able to lift 25-lb equipment cases and help carry to the top of the bleachers. Assist with equipment set-up with guidance and direction from the Producer.

LIVE BROADCAST ANNOUNCERS: - 2 PER GAME

On-air hosts of Pinnacle's live game broadcast - typically done as a team OR with a Lead Broadcaster + Assistant Broadcaster. Describes on-field action and discusses plays, strategy, players, stats and more. Broadcasters also thank our sponsors throughout each game.

The Broadcast Team will provide Broadcasters with team rosters, team and player stats, scripts, prompts, and sponsor blurbs so there is always plenty to talk about.

Experience: An upbeat personality plus a solid understanding of the game including formations, routes, strategies, rules/penalties.

Assistant Broadcaster - Adds commentary and color to the Broadcast via conversations with the Lead Broadcaster and assists with sponsor reads, announcements, etc. This is a great role for an individual who is less experienced with the technical aspects of game play.

CAMERA OPERATOR - CLOSE SHOTS: (HOME GAMES ONLY)

The Close Camera zooms in for close-ups on huddles, snaps, and action before and after each play. Also shoots close ups of the Cheer, Pom, and fans during time outs. Close camera operators do not need to keep the ball in the shot during the play as the producer will switch to the wide camera after the snap.

Experience: Knowledge of football is a plus however no camera experience is required. Cameras are stationed on a tripod and are easy to operate, requiring little more than a smooth touch and the operator's ability to follow game play. Training will be provided.

CAMERA OPERATOR - WIDE SHOTS:

The wide camera is positioned to capture the full offense and defense and follows the ball from snap to down completion. Captures shots of Cheer, Pom, Fans, and Crazies during time-outs. Also captures Half-Time events at Home Games

Experience: Knowledge of football is a plus however no camera experience is required. Cameras are stationed on a tripod and are easy to operate, requiring little more than a smooth touch and the operator's ability to follow game play. Training will be provided.

GAME STADIUM PA ANNOUNCER: (HOME GAMES ONLY)

Be the Voice of the Pioneers by verbalizing the on-field action, the team rosters, statistics and sponsor blurbs for the game attendees.

Experience: A solid understanding of the game of football is required.

SPOTTER: (HOME GAMES ONLY)

Assists the PA Announcer by quickly referencing the roster to relay the player name(s) & jersey #(s) of the key playmakers after each play. May need to use binoculars when gameplay is down field.

SCOREBOARD/CLOCK OPERATOR: (HOME GAMES ONLY)

Operates the Scoreboard and Game Clock from the air-conditioned Press Box.

Requirements: Ability to remain focused and pay attention to detail. Training will be provided.

STADIUM DJ: (HOME GAMES ONLY)

Pump up the fans with great music during pre-game, time-outs, and halftime. The DJ chooses and plays music from a pre-selected playlist on an iPad. The DJ also works closely with Pom & Cheer to play select music for their sideline routines.

Experience: Creative music-lover with good situational awareness skills. Comfortable with operating an iPad and following cues from Stadium Announcer and Pom/Cheer squad. This is a great opportunity for a mature student who loves music and pumping up the crowd. Qualifies for volunteer hours.

Note: We welcome Student Volunteers for many broadcast positions. Volunteer hours are available for Students who volunteers for the Live Broadcast. Students must commit to some training prior to volunteering at a game.

GAME-DAY SUPPORT

CONCESSIONS

Assist the concessions team with sales, setup and cleanup. For questions contact concessions@pinnaclefootball.com.

MERCHANDISE SALES

Volunteers needed to set up merchandise table, arrange sales items, and assist customers with purchase of Pinnacle Fan gear. Payments of Cash or Credit will be processed. Volunteers will be needed until the start of the third quarter.

SPECIALY NIGHTS

Coordinates Specialty Nights at Varsity Games such as Military Appreciation, Breast Cancer Awareness, Homecoming, Senior Night, Phoenix Storm/Junior Cheer nights, etc.

GAME DAY MEAL PREP/SUPPORT

One or two volunteers to assist caterer with game day player meals (home and away) ensuring meals are easily served and everything runs smoothly! This is a wonderful opportunity to also get to know all the players!

The caterer does most of the work and volunteers hand out napkins, utensils, and drinks and take the leftovers inside for the coaches. Assist with wiping tables following service. *Food is typically served between 2:30 & 3:00 pm for Frosh & JV games and 3:30-4:00 pm for Varsity Games.*

COMMITTEES & OTHER SUPPORT

BANQUET COMMITTEE (1 Lead per Team + Volunteers)

1 Team lead and multiple volunteers to plan and coordinates the End of Season Banquet for each team.

TEAM REPS - FROSH, JV, & VARSITY (2 Reps per team)

Team Reps are the main point of contact and the primary point of communication and support for families throughout the season. Reps disseminate team-related announcements and information designed to keep families in the loop, provide assistance when questions arise, and can offer support when completing registration and other required documents.

Team Reps work closely with their Head Coach get weekly practice schedules and other team information and help to ensure information is going both ways.

VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR

Works with committee leads to post volunteer positions on Dibs

MEMBERSHIP (Booster Club)

Coordinates Family Night and Booster Club Membership Drive.

FUNDRAISING / CORPORATE SPONSORSHIP

JV/VARSITY CAMP COORDINATOR

Works with Coach Zupke to plan meals, snacks, drinks, transportation, and fun activities for the JV & Varsity Training Camp in July. Communicates details to Board / Team Reps for family communication.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Plans and coordinates opportunities for players and families to "give-back" to the community. Activities have included volunteer days at St. Mary's Foodbank, fundraisers/donations for local charities, Holiday gift-giving to those in needs. The sky's the limit here!

MONTHLY DINE-OUT FUNDRAISERS

Plans and coordinates monthly Dine-to-Donate events. Procures venues and communicates information to Board & Team Reps to promote.

PRE-GAME MEET-UP/HAPPY HOUR COORD

Plans and coordinates Varsity pre-game meet-ups by procuring space at local restaurants on game nights (both Home and Away games). Communicates with Board and Team Reps who promote to families.

ALL THINGS SENIOR (1 Lead + Volunteers)

Plans and coordinates all senior football player-related activities including Senior Night, Senior Photo Shoot, Senior Gifts, etc.
