



This flyer is a reminder to be courteous to the neighbors that live near our sports fields and suggestions of what we can do to prevent use conflicts with the neighbors while visiting their neighborhood.

Tualatin Hills Park and Recreation District is asking for your cooperation in maintaining a neighbor friendly environment.

- Do not park in areas signed “NO PARKING.”
- Do not park on yellow or red painted curbs.
- Do not park in cul-de-sacs or on dead end streets.
- Do not park in front of mailboxes, driveways, pedestrian access points or sidewalks.
- Do not park on curbs, in right of ways or un-designated parking spaces.
- Avoid narrow streets or streets where small children may be playing when possible.

To maintain a more positive relationship with our neighbors, we are asking everyone to be more conscious of their parking habits.

- Please park in designated sports field parking lots first, school lots as a second choice and on the street as a last resort.
- Please leave ample room for the residents to have parking for their visitors.
- When parking on the street, be aware of landscaping and blind corners as well as bike lanes/paths.
- Take a moment and patrol the area for litter before leaving.
