Indicated that the Team Packets do not have schedules in them – the Field Coordinator should arrive later in the meeting with them. Unfortunately not enough validation stickers were ordered so some teams would not be able to pick up their packets tonight – once she

receives the additional validation stickers she will place them on the ID cards and contact each Captain to arrange for delivery. Packets include the 2007 Board and Commissioners list. Introduced 3 new commissioners – Shelly Miller, Sheri DeGuia and Sylvia Brown. There were 116 teams this season – 4 more than in the Fall. All packets include an acknowledgment form that each representative must sign in order to receive their packets – form indicates that each representative/Captain is responsible for their teammates in reading and abiding by Richland College rules. The league lost 3 fields at Richland because of teams not abiding by the rules. If teams violate the rules at Richland the season those teams will forfeit their right to have Richland as their home field next season. Waivers must be turned in tonight – no waiver=no packet. If you are missing ID's see Talina after the meeting – she will check her pending folder. Team placements this season was a hard job taking almost 4 hours to complete.
