

INVESTING IN THE FUTURE OF SNOWSPORTS

One of the main objectives of Bogus Basin Ski Club is to sustain snowsports in order to ensure that the inspirational experiences of snowsports will remain for future generations. The Bob Greenwood SNOWSPORTS Scholarship was established to recognize Bob Greenwood as one of our iconic community members. The importance of his industry contributions, dedication and connections to our ski community span the decades and embodies the legacy for which this award represents. Our purpose is threefold:

1. To provide financial aid to a junior snowsports competitor.
2. To award a student athlete who excels at his/her level and snowsports discipline.
3. To develop a personal relationship with a junior competitor as outreach with an eye toward building present and future membership with the athletes and their family and friends.

Purpose. Bogus Basin Ski Club has adopted the three objectives and continues to raise funds to help support young Bogus Basin snowsports student athletes to achieve their racing goals. The scholarship will assist student athletes who are committed to pursuing alpine or nordic snowsports which encompass race programs that stem from Bogus Basin. Scholarship funds may be used to offset training expenses and competition entrance fees, but may not be used for personal travel or equipment.

Criteria. Judging award placement for scholarship is based on achievement in one or more disciplines: alpine, nordic, freestyle, big mountain, halfpipe, slopestyle, or competitive ranking and academics. In addition, the applicant's goals, community service and financial needs will be components of scholarship. Community involvement will also be considered.


Selection Committee. The core committee is comprised of individuals with prior experience based on one or a combination of the following: alpine and/or nordic ski coaching, alpine and/or nordic racing, community service, Bogus Basin Ski Club members and/or volunteer positions that encompass Bogus Basin alpine and/or nordic racing. This committee will select the scholarship finalists and comply with the Bogus Basin Ski Club's objectives.

Who is Eligible. A Bogus Basin student-athlete competitor who is currently a United States Ski and Snowboard licensed for U14 (12-13 years old), U16 (14-15 years old) or U18 (16-17 years old) competing in a US affiliated program is eligible to apply for a scholarship. We look to make our scholarship selection with an eye toward expectations of the long-term contributions that the student athlete may make to the snowsports community and the larger community as well.

Date Due & Application Process. 2025-26 Applications for the scholarship are due digitally by **December 8, 2025**. The selection committee will announce the winners during the month of **December 2025**.

2025-26 Snowsports Scholarship Winners' Availability. You are expected to schedule your availability for two Bogus Basin Ski Club events. You will be notified in advance of the dates and asked to confirm your participation. You'll be invited, along with your family members and friends, to attend the following two Bogus Basin Ski Club's annual events:

1. **BBSC Membership Brunch--September 2026 Location:** Kristin Armstrong Park, Walnut Street. You'll be introduced to our membership and friends. You will be given an opportunity to speak about your season accomplishments and how the scholarship has assisted your snowsports participation.
2. **Warren Miller Film at the Egyptian Theatre, Boise.** You will be recognized on stage at the **November 2026 Saturday matinee**.



2025-26 BBSC Scholarship Application Guide

Due December 8, 2025

Completed applications are due electronically to the Bogus Basin Scholarship Committee at kimhovren@yahoo.com.

A complete application includes:

1. **The Application Form:** This is a downloadable .pdf file. Both the applicant and a parent/guardian must sign the Application Form.
2. **Biographical Sketch** to include:
 - a. How do you combine education with ski competition and your educational goals? What is your Grade Point Average (GPA)? Please include your most recent report card.
 - b. Community Service: In what other organizations, sports, activities, or events do you participate?
 - c. What excites you about competition?
 - d. What are your favorite memories of racing and/or training? How many days per month do you train?
 - e. What are your competition objectives for this season?
 - f. Financial Need: Racing and training events can be expensive. Why are you in need of financial assistance? Specifically, what are you doing to help support your racing? Are there specific hardships at home? What other funding resources do you receive through awards or scholarships? How much do you estimate your fees for racing and training will be for this season?
 - g. What does sportsmanship mean to you?
 - h. How do you now or plan to give back to your alpine community regarding racing?
 - i. Tell us of your accomplishments and/or special awards you have received.

3. **Letters of Recommendation:** Two letters of recommendation are required. One letter should be from the athlete's club or coach. Other letter recommendations may come from a community service contact, school teacher, client or employer. These letters are important, as they may provide supporting documentation for an athlete's involvement in their community or bring emphasis to something the athlete deems important. A letter of recommendation from a family member or guardian, unless it is a place of business or work for the applicant, will not be considered.
4. **Photos:** A head and shoulders photo along with a competition photo, in a .jpg, .pdf or other digital format to be used for possible publication.
5. **2025-26 Application Deadlines:** Completed digital application must arrive no later than **December 8, 2025**. Please scan in .pdf or .jpg format. Pictures of your application using a phone device will not be accepted. The Scholarship committee chooses nominees in the month of December and you'll be notified accordingly.

Winners will be selected in the month of December 2025

Methods of scholarship payment:

1) Funds for successful applicant(s) will be deposited to the team/club designated administrator and used to offset competition costs for the athlete(s) current season.

OR

2) It will be the responsibility of the winner and their parent/guardian to determine the proper application of the funds, in accordance to the athlete's competition season.

Application and the information therein is for the exclusive use of the Bob Greenwood Snowsports Scholarship Committee and can be summarized (no personal information will be included) in the Bogus Basin Ski Club *Mogul* when announcing winners. Information will not be used for any purpose other than the award of scholarships, except as noted above.
