

NEBRASKA AMATEUR SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME NOMINATION PACKET

Purpose – To honor those men and women who have played a major role in the growth and development of softball in the State of Nebraska and to help bring to the attention of the public the widespread value of, and interest in, the game of softball by so honoring those who have made outstanding contributions to its success.

Nomination Requirements

- An individual shall be considered for nomination to the Nebraska Softball Hall of Fame based on their contributions to softball in Nebraska.
- The person so nominated must have been a resident of Nebraska at the time of their contribution to Nebraska Softball.
- Nominations must be received on or before September 1st to be considered.
- At least 5 reference letters providing career and background information must be received. We would like to have 10 if at all possible. This allows for diverse information.
- If available, copies of scrapbook and newspaper clippings are necessary and **will not** be returned.
- All reference letters will be presented to each nominee at the Awards Banquet.
- All nominations ***must*** include a photograph of the nominee, which **will be returned**.
- All nominations not accepted, may be resubmitted the following year.

Categories

- Players
 - Must have played or been active in Nebraska Softball for a minimum of ten (10) years and have been inactive for at least three (3) years. EXCEPTION: A person over 40 years of age may be eligible if they played over 20 years.
- Umpires
 - Must have been registered and umpired fifteen (15) years for Nebraska Softball.
 - Must have worked at least one (1) National Championship and five (5) State Championships.
 - Must be held in high esteem by the State Umpire Staff, players and coaches for their ability on and off the field.
- Managers
 - Must have managed at least fifteen (15) years in Nebraska ASA.
- Sponsors
 - Must have sponsored a team(s) for at least fifteen (15) years in Nebraska ASA.
- Commissioners
 - Must have been a Nebraska ASA commissioner for at least ten (10) years.
 - Must be held in high esteem by the State Commissioner for their contributions to Nebraska ASA.
- Meritorious Service
 - Must have at least ten (10) years of service to the Nebraska ASA.
 - Contributions must have reflected an impact in the Nebraska ASA and can include any combination of the above categories in addition to an organizer-builder, financial contributor, etc.

Awards

- A specially designed plaque shall be presented to those elected to the Hall of Fame.
- A specially designed plaque will be displayed in the Hall of Fame in honor of those elected.

Presentation

- Will be made at the Annual Hall of Fame Awards Banquet in January.
- Recipients must be present to be inducted.
