



USIBA National Championship Team Scoring Policy

USIBA awards a Men's Team Title and a Women's Team Title to schools with the most points across Beginner, Novice, and Open divisions.

Boxers must win a tournament bout to receive points. Byes, walkovers, first bout losses in semifinals or finals match, do not count toward team points. For example, if there are only two boxers entered in a Novice bracket, the winner receives four (4) team points, but the loser receives none.

Team Scoring:

- Beginner Division: 1st place = 3 points.
2nd place = 2 points.
Winning a quarterfinal match = 1 point.
- Novice Division: 1st place = 4 points.
2nd place = 3 points.
Winning a quarterfinal match = 2 points.
- Open Division: 1st place = 5 points.
2nd place = 4 points.
Winning a quarterfinal match = 3 points.

Multiple boxers from a school: Each school receives team points for one boxer per weight division. For example, if a boxer wins the 141 Open division and their teammate had a quarterfinal win, then only five (5) points are awarded to the school for team title standing (the 3 points for the quarterfinal win of the teammate would not count).

Challenges: If a boxer wins their division, and successfully challenges a boxer in a higher-skill division, the team points are awarded for the higher-skill division won. For example, if a Novice Champion challenges an unopposed Open boxer and wins, their team gets five (5) points. If the Novice Champion loses to the Open boxer, the Novice boxer's team gets four (4) points and the Open boxer's team gets five (5) points.
