4. Secretary Report (Jeff)

- None

5. Concessions Report (Anna)

- Revenue to date is approximately \$20,000 (~ \$6,000-\$7,000/Game)
- Hot Dog roller was purchased from the RRTOC for \$50
- Plan is to work to sell out remaining inventory by seasons end
- Anna may return some soda as the expiration date is soon
- Home game this week with an anticipated chilly forecast. Anna will stock the concession stand with additional hot chocolate
- Anna reminded those present that our margins are small on most items that are not donated.
- Anna shared that the cost per Hankie was ~\$6. Tynanne indicated that we needed to sell about 50% of our inventory (@\$10/hankie) to break even.
- With the rain that occurred during the Homecoming game, Maynards/Ryf did not sell burgers. This was not communicated. Plans are to ensure better communication in the future.

6. Coach Franz Report (Marc)

- Coach shared that “B Squad” is defined as JV/Sophomore in the NWSC
- Coach mentioned that going forward non-10 through 12 varsity games will be “B-Squad” games.
- “B-Squad” plays in Brainerd this week. Tynanne mentioned the character bus, water, gatorade and plans for pizza afterward.
- Coach mentioned the injured Brainerd player and the Go Fund Me that has been established. The QB will reference the Go Fund Me and a card (signed by the team) may also be shared with the Brainerd team/athlete/family.
- Coach mentioned that he anticipates at least one more home game for the playoffs.
- Coach shared that a 9B game vs Chaska was added on 10.17.22.
- For the Moorhead game, the freshman and varsity will play at Moorhead on 10.19.22. Freshman game at 4 PM with the Varsity game at 7 PM. Pizza will be provided to the freshman after their game and the varsity after their game. Players may ride home with family members provided they notify their respective coaches in advance.
- Rogers football was the recipient of the KARE 11 Hot Highlight. Along with the award, a check for \$1,000 was donated to the program.

7. President/Coordinators Report (Sara and Coordinators)

- Lori mentioned the Tackle Cancer cancer game this week
 - Jessica, Jane, and Sara shared plans for Senior Night and the banner reveal.
