Ski Trail Groomer

Sandpoint Nordic Club (SNC) is looking to hire a Lead Groomer to maintain ski trails at Pine Street Woods. The grooming is accomplished using a snowmobile that pulls a grooming device. The Lead Groomer would organize the schedule of all ski trail grooming and be supported by several volunteer groomers. In addition the Lead Groomer is responsible for caring for the equipment, including making arrangements for maintenance and repairs. When snow conditions permit, the trails are groomed daily and it usually takes about two hours to groom the trails. There are four volunteer groomers that can be utilized for about half of the days that we groom. Grooming is normally done between the hours of 7pm and 7am; however, it is dependent upon snow and weather conditions. We typically begin grooming trails in December and the season usually ends in March. Training will be provided.

- Willing to work at night
- Able to work in all types of winter weather
