

Middlesex League Meeting – Sunday, May 10th 7pm

If we are allowed to play and it remains a BIG IF.

1. Registration form is due June 1st
That would include, team's, age groups, day of the week that you could play home games and what your home field will be. We understand some of this may change but we need to know as much as possible on the date.

If you don't have a home field in 2020 and need to play all games on the road, you will need to make sure you have a willing group of parents that are all dedicated to make it happen. We do not want forfeits...
2. Payment for the league will be due on June 15th
We will start working on the schedule at that point
3. Cost – registration fee for the 2020 season is \$250
That will include game balls, scorebooks etc...
That does not include umpire fees that are paid at the field
Home teams are required to pay umpires \$50 before the start of the game.
4. All teams must register and insure the players and coaches through www.registerusasoftball.com
On that site you will also need to make sure that all of your coaches, volunteers, scorekeepers etc...(18 years and older) complete the background check and Safesport certification. Keep in mind that each individual must go into that site and create a username and password and complete both of those. You cannot do it for them. Background check is \$10 and Safesport is free if you're a USA Softball member (which you are). Make sure you go through Safesport through our www.registerusasoftball.com site. If you're being charged for Safesport that is a red flag that you have done something wrong.
5. We will use the current Middlesex league rules for 2020. No changes to the rules for this season and we will be posting them on the USA Softball of Massachusetts website soon. That site is www.usasoftballma.com
6. We have submitted a return to play document to the governor's task force specifically. You need to discuss with your parents and your players before registration. Would your team want to play this season if we are playing under social distancing guidelines. Those guidelines could include wearing facemasks, limited attendance at games, distancing in the dugout are some examples.
7. Tentative start date is Monday, July 6th with a 7 week season. 14 games.
