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## **Alcohol and Drug Policy**

### **Alcohol and Tobacco**

The use of alcohol and tobacco (including vaping and electronic cigarettes) is prohibited by members (players, coach, manager, administrator, board member, volunteer or any other person in a designated role) while participating in their designated role within Nevada Amateur Hockey Association (NAHA) membership.

This policy does not prohibit members from possessing or using alcoholic beverages when they are not participating in their designated role within their NAHA membership. Any use of alcoholic beverages to the point of being under the influence, is prohibited. Members are prohibited from serving alcohol to others who appear to be under the influence, or to those under the legal drinking age.

### **Non-Prescription and Prescription Drugs**

NAHA has a zero-tolerance policy which prohibits members from using or being under the influence of illegal drugs, and/or non-prescribed controlled substances while participating in USA Hockey and NAHA sanctioned events.

This policy does not prohibit the proper use of medication prescribed by a physician; however, misuse of such prescription is prohibited. This policy also applies to the abusive use of non-prescription, over-the-counter products.

This policy is in place and enforceable at any time an individual is participating in their role within their NAHA membership, including but not limited to on-ice practices, games, scrimmages, exhibitions, tournaments, off-ice training and program-related events, local and team travel.

NAHA members in violation of this policy may be subject to disciplinary procedures, including but not limited, to suspension or termination of their membership pending the outcome of an investigation.
