 - **DRAFT approved:** Greenville Youth Sports tournament teams are designed to offer players with an increased level of skill and interest an opportunity to play in a competitive tournament environment. Greenville Griffins tournament teams are an extension of Greenville Youth Sports (GYS) and are governed by the GYS board.

GYS tournament teams will encompass the GYS mission to provide the best learning environment, the best competition and encourage fun while developing players. GYS tournament teams are designed to be a development program, with a long term goal of providing area high school baseball programs with a large

talent pool of diversified players that are well versed in the fundamentals of baseball.
