



2020 LEVELING SHOWCASE PROTOCOLS & FORMAT

All current rink protocols relating to Covid-19 must be observed including, but not limited to, social distancing, wearing of masks and locker room use, this is a partial list and the key points. For a complete list see the StarCenter website.

- Team locker rooms will not be available until 15 minutes prior to your game. That means your players should plan to dress and drive to games. We ask that teams do not enter the building until just prior to your locker room time. Players should come dressed, except for skates and will not be permitted to dress anywhere in the building including hallways, bleachers or lobby areas. **TEAMS MUST HAVE A LOCKER ROOM MONITOR TO MAKE SURE MASKS ARE WORN IN THE LOCKER ROOM.**
- Masks must always be worn inside the building by everyone over the age of 2. The only exception is players and officials on the ice. Coaches, spectators and staff must always PROPERLY wear a mask. Players must wear them in the locker room & coaches must wear them on the bench.
- Everyone must practice social distancing. Spread out in the seating areas and separate when standing near the glass. Keep your mask up over your nose.
- Teams must exit their locker room in 15 minutes or less after the game and exit the facility as soon as possible.
- We RECOMMEND only 1 guest per player. While not mandatory it is for everyone's safety that we try to limit attendance. In Richardson, due to the limited space, please limit attendance to 1 Guest.
- Only participating players and coaches are permitted on the bench. No injured, suspended or rostered players who are not playing in the game may be on the bench during games.
- If you or your player feel ill, do not attend any game or team function.

GAME FORMAT

- All games will be played in 1-hour slots with 3, 11-minute, stop-time periods.
- All USAH/AT&T MSHSL Rules are in effect unless otherwise noted.
- Carry over suspensions from the 19-20 season and/or the 2020 Summer Season will be served in REGULAR SEASON GAMES. All players will be eligible for Leveling. Penalties assessed in Leveling games that result in a suspension will carry over into the Regular 2020-21 Season.
- There will be no OT or Shootouts. Games ending in a tie at the end of regulation will be scored as a tie.
- This is not a tournament and there are no champions or awards. These games are for the leveling only.
