

## **COACH CONDUCT AGREEMENT**

NCBA is thankful for our parent volunteers who agree to coach the teams in the league. In order to promote a positive and safe environment for our kids and families, NCBA coaches are expected to adhere to the following guidelines.

### **Zero Tolerance Policy**

No coach in NCBA should get ejected from a game. If a coach is ejected from a game, he/she will be relieved of their coaching duties for the duration of the season.

1. I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the wide range of emotional and physical development for the same age group and place the player's emotional and physical well being ahead of my personal desire to win
2. I will be a positive role model for my players and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every game, practice, or other related sporting event.
3. I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for my players.
4. I will remember that I am youth sports coach and that the game is for the children and not the adults.
5. I will be a role model for behavior during games as it relates to the officials and opponent coaches
6. I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging and teach skills using coaching techniques that are age appropriate.
7. I will abide by all the league rules and make certain that ALL players play the necessary amount of time according to the PLAYER SUB GRIDS
8. I will NEVER come to practices or games under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs. I recognize that violation of this rule will result in the immediate dismissal from participation in NCBA.
9. Vehement argument with officials, opposing coaches, spectators, or site directors will not be tolerated. No profane language will be allowed.
