Instructions for players and parents

It is time to start prepping for the Saints Rugby 2nd biggest fundraiser: **Egg My Yard!** Below you will find detailed information on how this fundraiser works! 100% of this fundraiser is fueled by donations by players and parents and 99% of the work will be completed by our players! Players will collect donations, stuff and organize eggs and deliver eggs as a part of this fundraising effort with the goal to deliver 10,000 eggs Easter Eve!

1) Procurement of supplies:

- ◆ Please consider a donation of eggs, candy, or both! All supplies will be collected at rugby practices. All collections must be turned in by **Friday, March 8th**! Players can hand over their donations to Max, Caroline or Michael Doerfler
- ◆ You will receive an invitation to a Sign-Up Genius to sign up for a donation slot.

- ◆ In an effort to keep our eggs consistent and get the best bang for our buck (yes-even the Easter Bunny is a victim of inflation!), please consider the following when purchasing eggs or candy:

-Sets of 300, 518, and 2000 eggs are available



- ◆ Candy is most effectively purchased in bulk at **Sam's Club or Costco**. We need 10,000 pieces of individually wrapped candy. Kid approved candy includes name-brand candy such as **M&Ms, Skittles, Reese's, Starburst, or Hershey's**. Fun-size candy works perfectly for stuffing one piece of candy in one egg. PLEASE keep in mind the size of candy you purchase in relation to a regular-sized plastic egg. I know it sounds nitpicky but it makes assembly of 10,000 eggs on a short timeline much easier!

- ◆ If you do not have time to shop, consider a monetary donation! Donations can be made via Venmo **@Lauren-Doerfler-3** and I will purchase supplies!

3) Stuffing and Organizing Eggs

◆Immediately after practice (5:30 pm) on **Thursday, March 21st**, players and managers will gather for dinner and egg stuffing.

-Dinner will be served outside at STA (weather permitting) or in the STA back hall between the two gyms

-Egg stuffing will occur in the Learning Commons

-Parents can pick up their players at the end of the evening from STA at 8 pm.

-We will need a few parents to help manage the work this evening. Please refer to the Signup Genius to sign up to come help!
