Regarding: Football Equipment

Coaches, Parents/Guardians:

In years past, we have always collected football equipment (helmet and shoulder pads) from our participants, by staff following them to each of their Kiwanis Bowl Games.

This year, we will be doing something different. We have set a date and time for equipment drop off on Saturday, November 21st from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m.. This date is the drop date to return equipment to our office. If your child's team was eliminated from the Kiwanis Bowl tournament prior to this date, you do have the opportunity to bring back their equipment prior to the date set forth. When dropping off your equipment at the office, it is very important to please make sure staff gets your child's name so we can properly mark off that it is returned. On the date mentioned above, all you simply need to do is drive up to our office and we will be outside to grab it from you. The process shouldn't take but a few seconds of your time.

After the date and time of Saturday, November 21st from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m., if our records indicate no equipment has been dropped off for your child, then a \$100 balance will be issued to your account and your account will also be flagged, not allowing any registration(s) for any program(s) to occur for ALL account members till either equipment has been returned or the \$100 balance has been paid.

The fee of \$100 will NOT be cut in half for one piece of equipment (helmet or shoulder pads) returned. The full amount will still be collected in the event of one piece of equipment not returned.

When returning equipment, please make sure mouth guards are not attached and any stickers that have been placed on the helmet are taken off. The helmet decals should be left on the helmet.

Jerseys and pants are yours to keep. There is no need to return those.
