STATEMENT ON THE STATUS

“The War at the Shore Wrestling Tournament” has officially been moved to April 25th and 26th

The ACWA is sensitive to the COVID-19 (Corona Virus) situation in our area and want to ensure the wrestling public that we are doing all possible things for our wrestlers and spectators to provide a safe environment for them to complete at this year's War at the Shore Wrestling Tournament. The ACWA has taken several steps to facilitate this. First and foremost, the event's dates have been changed to Saturday and Sunday, April 25th and 26th. Hopefully, the Corona Virus pandemic will have substantially subsided by then. The Wildwood Convention Center is able to provide no-touch bathrooms (door handles, toilets, sinks and dryers) and will locate hand sanitizing stations throughout the venue. Additionally, the ACWA will provide mat and body wipes at each table, as well as the head table, throughout the tournament. The Wildwoods Convention Center has told the ACWA that the venue will remain open unless otherwise mandated by the State of New Jersey. The Convention Center's Housing Director has moved the dates of ALL existing hotel reservations to the same relative dates around the new weekend schedule. If you had a reservation for Thursday and Friday nights, they are now set for Friday and Saturday nights, with checkout on Sunday morning.
