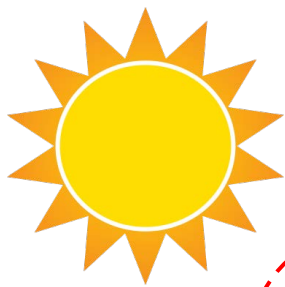

25th number pulled	Ticket holder receives \$25
50th number pulled	Ticket holder receives \$25
75th number pulled	Ticket holder receives \$25
100th number pulled	Ticket holder receives \$25
125th number pulled	50/50 Raffle is pulled
150th number pulled	Lights are turned on. Short break from the Mainboard & Sideboard Raffles. Simple Raffle tickets are pulled and Simple Raffle winnings distributed. Participants are encouraged to bid on Silent Auction items.
175th number pulled	Silent Auction ends with collection of bid sheets. Winners determined and payment totals tabulated. Silent Auction items to be distributed later.

## Silent Auction

Please mark your bid for your favorite item(s) on the bid sheet located in front of the item(s). The initial minimum bid will be placed by RHS hockey boosters to begin the bidding process. You can bid more than once but ALL bids *must* be in whole dollar increments. Please place and raise bids accordingly. When the 150<sup>th</sup> number on the Reverse Raffle Mainboard is pulled, the lights are turned on and participants are encouraged to bid on silent auction items. The silent auction ends (bid sheets collected) when the 175<sup>th</sup> number is pulled. The auction items are awarded and payments collected when the 200<sup>th</sup> number is pulled. Cash, check, or credit cards are all acceptable forms of payment.

## Simple Raffle Items and Baskets

Simple Raffle Tickets will be sold throughout the evening in **bundles of six (6) tickets for \$5 or 15 tickets for \$10**. When the 150<sup>th</sup> number on the Reverse Raffle Mainboard is selected, Simple Raffle tickets will be pulled and the raffle items distributed. A "last call" announcement will alert participants of the opportunity to buy tickets shortly before the closing of the Simple Raffle. Silent Auction bids are encouraged after.

# Rules Of The Game

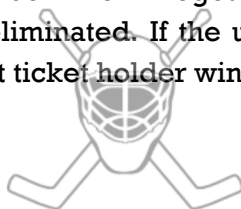
The first (1) number drawn wins \$50. That winner has the option of pulling the next 24 numbers.

The 25th, 50th, 75th, 100th, and 125th numbers drawn will win \$25 each and also have the option of pulling the next 24 numbers.

The remaining numbers will be pulled by the event announcer until there are five (5) numbers remaining, then after the addition of the **Hamilton 13** (formerly "Lucky Number '7'") number, all remaining six numbers will be drawn by a Roosevelt Ice Hockey Booster Club Board Member or a Team Coach.

Throughout the evening **Hamilton 13** tickets will be sold for the cost of \$5/ ticket or bundles of **five (5) tickets for \$20**. When there are five (5) numbers remaining the **Hamilton 13** ticket will be drawn. The individual winning the drawing will then assume possession of the number **13** from the Mainboard and all Sideboards and be entered into the raffle as the sixth (6th) contestant remaining on all boards. The host will then add the **Hamilton 13** number ball into the hopper and proceed with the raffle.

When five (5) numbers remain, the participating five ticket holders, or their representatives, will form a group and be given five (5) minutes to reach a unanimous decision as to split or continue with the drawing. If any of the last five ticket holders are not present, or do not have a representative present, there can be no negotiation to split until that number has been eliminated. If the unrepresented number is the final number, that ticket holder wins the Mainboard payout.

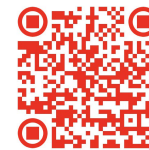
