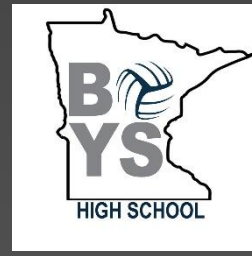

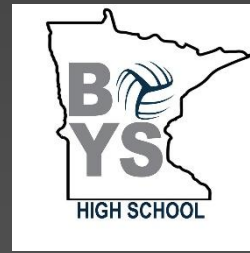

League Rules

- ◉ League Rules will follow MSHSL...
 - > Key differences to note vs. club volleyball
 - Coaches submit SERVICE order on their line-up sheet
 - Varsity Warm-ups are 20 minutes
 - 4 shared, 6 visitors, 6 home, 2 visitor service, 2 home service
 - JV Warm-ups are 10 minutes (5 visitor, 5 home)
 - Time-out duration is 60 seconds (with a 15 sec warning)
 - Team is allowed 18 total substitutions
 - Teams do NOT switch sides in the middle of the 3rd/5th set



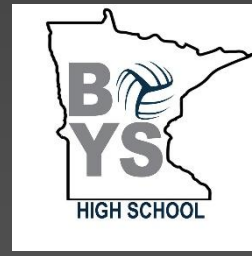
Modifications from MSHSL

- Ball Handling - “Illegal Hit” (lift/catch/throw)

MSHSL RULE: Legal contact is a touch of the ball by any part of a player’s body which does not allow the ball to visibly come to rest or involve prolonged contact with a player’s body.

- > **Modification for this league** – there will NOT be leniency!
This extends to ALL team contacts (1st, 2nd and 3rd).

NOTE: While “technique” is not judged for legality, actions such as tipping to the opponents with your back to the net, power tips, and using an open hand (in an underhand motion) to “dig” a ball all have a statistically low chance of being carried out without prolonged contact.



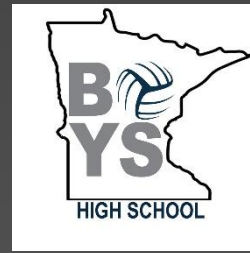
Modifications from MSHSL

● Ball-Handling - “Double contact”

MSHSL RULE: multiple contact on a first team hit (even with finger action) with one attempt to play the ball is allowed.

- > **Modification for this league** – this rule extends to ALL team contacts (1st, 2nd and 3rd), including a ball sent across the net to the opponents!

NOTE: 2 separate attempts to play the ball is still a fault



Modifications from MSHSL

◉ “Alignment (Positional) Fault”

MSHSL RULE: Players must be in the proper position (relative to teammates) at the time of service contact

- ◉ **Modification for this league** – the R1 will verbally assist to correct (repeatedly , if necessary) the position of the players on the court.
 - > If it is noticed before the serve is authorized: assist players (either directly, or through another player on the court) to correct their positions
 - > If it is noticed after beckon for service, allow play to continue as normal. **Do not call a fault!** After rally concludes, and point is awarded, verbally communicate to the offending team the correction they need to make.

NOTE: Only if teams INTENTIONALLY abuse this rule will a fault be called. Proactive officiating, combined with respectful participants, should prevent this from being an issue.

Libero Player

- ◉ Designation

- > 1 per set, but it can change each set

- ◉ Uniform

- > Jersey shall clearly contrast the team

- ◉ Restrictions

- > May not block or attempt to block
- > May serve in 1 (rotational/service) position
- > Enter/exit after rally & before service beckon
- > Restrictions on “attack hit” & “overhand finger pass” while in the front zone

When the Libero Serves

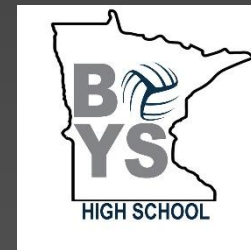
Sooner, or later, the libero will probably serve for a teammate.

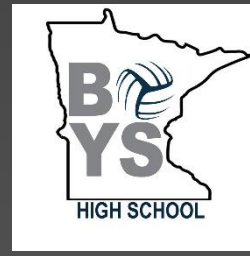
Line Judge Basics





Line Judge Basics

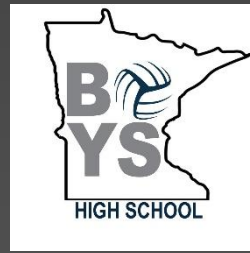
- ◉ Positioning
 - > Pre-service, during play & end of rally
- ◉ Signals
 - > Deliberate/confident
 - > Eye-contact with referee
- ◉ Responsibilities (FLAT)
 - > Foot fault, Lines (in/out), antenna fault, touch



Line Judge Positioning

- Location
 - > The 2 corners are to the right of the referees
 - > LONG line should be on your LEFT foot
- Stay very close to the corner! Except...
 - Server/player coming near you
 - To enhance your view on a “pancake” and/or when recognizing a possible “antenna fault” may occur
- Be athletic, engaged and professional
 - > Good body positioning and body language

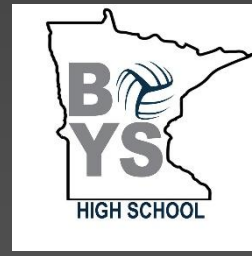
Line judge views

Balls coming at you



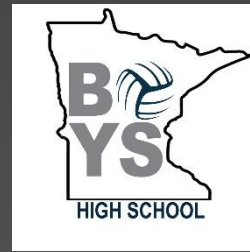


Line Judge Signals (FLAT)

- ◉ Foot Fault / Antenna Fault
 - > Ball has not yet hit the floor, thus we “wave”
 - > Other hand points at end line or antenna

- ◉ Lines
 - > Everything hitting the line or court, is “IN”
 - “IN” is used even if the balls is touched

- ◉ Touch vs. Out
 - > Determined by which team touched it last and what side of the net/centerline the ball lands on

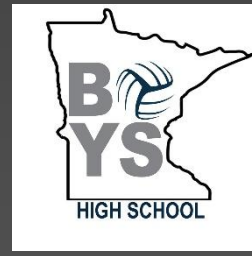


Line Judge - other

- Time-outs
 - > Go over near the R1 platform
 - > Stand at intersection of the sideline and 10' line
 - > Check if the R1 has any feedback to provide
 - > Be professional with the flags and volleyball

- Between sets
 - > Bring the ball back to the scorer's table
 - > Find a "neutral" place to sit/stand
 - > Be available in case R1 has feedback to provide

- End of match
 - > Return game ball and flags to the scorer's table
 - > Be available for feedback from the R1



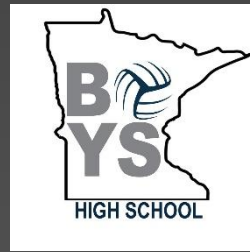
Line Judge - closing

- ⦿ Expectations from participants, coaches, fans
 - > You shouldn't be yelled...or even addressed
 - > Be professional and do not engage or respond
 - > Inform R1 if unsporting/rude conduct is directed at you

- ⦿ “Could not see” call
 - > Signal is crossing arms in front of chest
 - > Hope to avoid this by being engaged and active
 - > Should not be used if just uncertain about a “touch”

R2 Base position

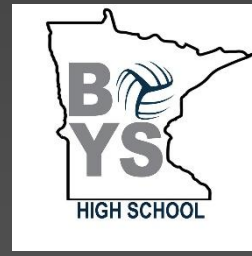


Distance from the court is about right

- ◉ “Court Manager” when ball is out of play
 - > Work with teams for sub and time-out requests
 - > Keep coaches and reserves in proper place
 - Primary communicator with bench and personnel
 - > SCAN, SCAN, SCAN....bench areas!

- ◉ Positioning
 - > Near net pole and scorer table
 - > Whistle should almost always be in mouth
 - > Move during play to be on side w/o the ball
 - > Repeat R1 signals at the end of each rally

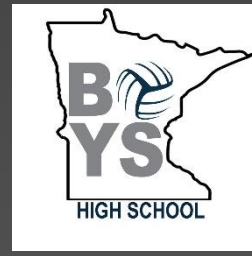
Signals during the match

3 most common results at end of a play:



R2 repeats all R1 signals

- > Except service beckon and a net serve



R2 responsibilities intro

- ◉ Blow whistle during dead ball for:
 - > Substitutions
 - > Time-outs
 - > Line-up/next server request

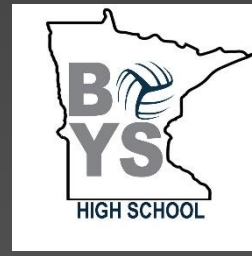
- ◉ Blow whistle during play for:
 - > Net fault
 - > Centerline fault
 - > Antenna fault (on your side of the court)
 - > Need to stop play (injury, ball on-court, etc.)

Faults at the net

- ◉ Penetration under the net
- ◉ Contact with the net

NOTE OF UTMOST IMPORTANCE!

- ◉ R2 must keep focus on these two items because everyone (R1 and Line judges) else is watching the ball
- ◉ Let's take a look at what to expect...



On-court sessions

- ◉ Utilize hitting lines for attacks
 - > Line Judges will call in/out/touch and maybe even get a chance for an antenna fault
- ◉ Scrimmage/wash drill
 - > R2 will work on transition and positioning
 - > Focus on net/centerline, NOT the ball
 - > R2 will repeat R1 signals at the end of rallies
 - > Then focus on benches for TO/sub requests

Other faults

- ◉ 4 hits
- ◉ Catch / throw (no leniency)
- ◉ ~~Double contact~~ (2 separate attempts!)
- ◉ Reaching beyond the net
- ◉ Attack hit fault (back-row or libero “set”)
- ◉ Blocking faults (back-row or libero)
- ◉ Positional(Alignment)/Rotational fault
- ◉ Sanctions / Delays / Improper requests

Pre-match reminders

- Forbidden Objects
 - > Jewelry and cast are forbidden
 - > Braces (w/ padding) and certain medical items can be allowed
- Line-ups
 - > Due w/ 2 minutes remaining in warm-ups
 - > Due w/ 30 second left between sets
- Short team huddle at end of warm-ups
 - > Teams line-up on end lines
 - > Whistle and bring teams to the net
 - > R1 checks line-ups then makes way to stand

Event administration items

◉ Items to check

- > Net – Height, padding, referee stand
- > Ball cart and 10+ volleyballs
- > Score table materials
 - Line-up sheets (same for both JV and Varsity)
 - Service order tracking sheets (JV and Varsity)
 - Score sheets (JV and Varsity)
 - Pens/pencil
 - Visual score/clock
