
Youth Hockey Covid Requirements

The Laramie Ice & Event Center is evaluating the changing environment surrounding the 2020 Covid-19 Pandemic on an ongoing basis and has used guidance and regulations from the State of Wyoming, CDC and US Ice Rink Association to determine our best practices. The following requirements are in effect for users in the facility.

1. All guests shall **complete a short health screening** before entering the facility.
2. **Guests who are feeling unwell will be asked to leave** to avoid potential exposure to the Covid-19 virus.
3. **Guests shall maintain a distance of 6ft.** between one another whenever possible.
4. The facility has a **capacity of 70 individuals** at any time.
 - a. During games, team members, managers, coaches and referees will not be included in the 70-person cap. Team rosters from WAHL will be used to check-in teams at the Front Desk, only individuals on these rosters will be excluded from the 70-person cap.
 - b. 30 minute gaps will be implemented between games to alleviate overflow during the transition of groups.
 - c. Teams will be granted access to the facility no earlier than **15 minutes** prior to the start of their games to minimize capacity issues.
5. **Locker room capacity is 5 individuals** per locker room.
6. **Face Coverings shall be worn in the facility** at all times except as specified below.
 - a. **Face Coverings must completely cover the mouth and nose. Face coverings with large holes will not be permitted for use in the facility.**


FACE COVERING EXCEPTIONS

- i. When a guest is **seated and consuming food or beverages in the lobby.**
- ii. For **skaters when they are on the ice** (during games and practices).
- iii. **When Ice & Event Center staff are required to be on the ice** face masks are required by all participants.

We appreciate the partnership with our user groups and expect that the Laramie Amateur Hockey Club will require compliance by their participants, spectators and visiting teams. These requirements will be strictly enforced and guests who refuse to comply will be asked to leave the facility.

The Laramie Ice & Event Center will continue to evaluate changes to the Covid-19 Pandemic response and additional changes may be implemented at any time. These changes will be effective as of **Tuesday, November 17th of 2020.**
