Refund Policy: Fees are due in full based on the program of services selected at the time a player register. As a convenience to families, the club offers different payment options and methods. A prorated refund of fees paid is only available if the player is required for medical reasons not to participate for 8 weeks or more within the same season, or if the family transfers more than 35miles from current residence. No refunds are provided after September 1, 2018.If a player should decide to withdraw from a season, seasonal fees remain due in full as the club commits staff and resources based on the services selected by families.

Fees are Estimates for Actual Services: As estimates of actual team expenses, these fees are subject to change based on the level of services provided. For example, Academy level teams may arrange for specialty training, or regional tournaments that are above and beyond the Club’s standard. In these cases, the Team Manager will advise participating families of the additional fees due and collect fees and make payments directly.
