- An update of the equipment inventory was provided by PSMHA equipment coordinator. She is going to make a recommendation to the board as to how many new sets of jerseys are required for the 2022-23 season.
- The center Ice logo will be replaced at Balgonie. There was a carried motion for the expense of \$3213.21. Logo will be done by Jet Ice. There was a carried motion to purchase pucks for next season and a mini net for Pilot Butte.
- Haztec will sponsor the medical kits again for next season.
- Jackie provided an update on the financials to the board members present.
- Funds will be reinvested at ScotiaBank in an investment account.
- SLGA Community Grant has been applied for with the Town of Pilot Butte.
- The AGM will be held at the Balgonie Multiplex on June 14, 2022. There are numerous open positions on the board this year and officer positions, a notice will be send out to the membership.
- A review was conducted of Hockey Sask rule changes and Zone meeting updates. Hockey Sask indicated that based on a survey that they sent out, to those that responded, the most important that parents would like to see is player development; most important takeaway for those that quit was feeling accepted. Barriers to playing hockey included: unfair tryouts, unfair

evaluations, team fees and fundraising, too high of fees, politics. Player and coach development committees is important.

- U15 provincial league has been approved and will be in effect in 2023/24. This league will be for 15 year olds not playing AAA.
- Our Executive Director will advise very soon what dates are available for the Officiating clinics
- The board discussed possible team composition for the 2022/23 year and fees. Registration will open up June 1, 2022 to existing players and July 4, 2022 for new players to the association. Second installment of fees will be required to be paid by August 15, 2022. All fees must be paid prior to any evaluations.
