



QUICK GUIDE: FIELD MAINTENANCE

1. Home team is responsible for pre-game and post-game field maintenance. Make sure to drag fields and clean-up (trash) post-game for next game/day. Sweep dugouts after games.
2. Fields must be watered first to keep down dust and then dragged after the last game or practice of the day. Water after dragging to solidify playing surface.
3. Remove center sprinkler trap caps before turning on sprinklers for K-2 and K-3.
4. Do not pull or drag infield dirt over grass edges, stay away from edges of the dirt and finish to the front of second or third base.
5. Make sure all sprinkler/water valves are shut off completely before leaving fields.
6. Do not use broken or damaged sprinklers. If necessary use the hose to water the field before dragging the field. K-1 will utilize the quick connect for the hose only.
7. Qualified ADULTS only on quad or driving the golf cart. Slow speeds while dragging. Do not sling dirt onto grass or pile in one place. Fuel is located in storage container, use funnel.
8. Replace all tools and equipment to proper storage area and secure as necessary.
9. Chalk should be used for the first game of the day and then sparingly thereafter. No chalk for practice, logos or anything unnecessary for the game.
10. Notify field maintenance of any issues related to field conditions, damaged or broken equipment.
