

Addendum to Snoopy's Home Ice Facility Use Rental Agreement

As the representative of Santa Rosa Youth Hockey League, you are required to read and confirm that you understand the **Guidelines for Youth & Coaches Participation at Snoopy's Home Ice**. You are required to circulate these agreements to the participants in the activity for which you are utilizing our facilities. You are required to take steps to ensure that participants act in accordance with the COVID-19 policies and procedures. Failure to adhere could result in your user group rental agreement to be revoked without refund of any fees and/or any person being banned from access to our facilities. It is vital that no person who feels sick in any way visit any of our facilities and/or utilize any of our services. It is also vital that no person brings a child who feels unwell or is showing any symptoms of illness to any of our facilities and/or programs.

It is vital that any person who believes that they may have contracted COVID or their child may have within 14 days of visiting our facility report this immediately to us by contacting General Manager at 707.546.7147 x206 or tamara@snoopyshomeice.com and seek appropriate medical attention. We will share personal information for the purposes of contact tracing if the need arises. To attend our facilities, all persons taking part in your activities must consent to the same.

Guidelines for Youth Hockey Participation at Snoopy's Home Ice

Skaters

- Take your temperature before coming to the rink. If you have a 100+ fever stay home!
- Must arrive fully dressed and ready to put skates on
- Must always wear face mask in the facility, including while on the ice
- Wash hands thoroughly before/after stepping on/off the ice and use hand sanitizer
- Use your own water bottle/food/equipment/gear
- Practice social distancing - 6 feet apart from others
- Keep all equipment and bags 6 feet apart including water bottles along the boards
- No hugging, high fiving, touching, group celebrations or other interactions closer than 6 feet
- Goalies must have undergarments & pants on before arrival and will have the ability to gear-up onsite in "station"

Coaches

- Must always wear face mask in the facility – mask is mandatory while on the ice
- Check with skaters on how they are feeling - send any sick players/skaters' home
- Ensure lessons and drills always allow for social distancing
- Be responsible and lead by example

Parents

- Take your child's temperature at home before coming to the rink. Please stay home if your child has a 100+ fever!
- Drop your child off at the door after completing screening questionnaire.
- If your child is under the age of 11 and needs help tying skates, one parent may accompany the child to assist and must leave after tying skates. This parent must wear a face mask while inside the facility.
- Supply child with their own labeled water bottle, hand sanitizer, tissues etc.
- No spectating as no parents are allowed in the rink apart from the above specified.

Coaches' Guidelines for Youth Hockey Participation at Snoopy's Home Ice

General Guidelines

- Individuals are not allowed in the arena if experiencing any symptoms of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
- Must always wear face mask in the facility – mask is mandatory while on the ice.
- Check with skaters on how they are feeling – required to send home any sick skaters.
- Ensure lessons and drills always allow for social distancing.
- Be responsible and lead by example.

On-Ice Sessions

- Reinforce the message that players need to observe physical distancing recommendations while on the ice.
- Avoid utilizing benches.
- Avoid drills that require players to stand in line.
- When designing practice have skaters spread out to maintain needed physical distancing.
- Minimize chalk talk sessions where players could congregate.
- Utilize non-contact drills.
- Be cognizant to avoid talking within close proximity of players' faces.
- When leaving the ice, excuse players one-by-one giving appropriate time for each player to get off the ice. Plan to leave an appropriate amount of time at the end of their ice session to complete the dismissal process while using café doors and west exit doors.

After Practice

- Have skaters put on their shoes or skate guards so that they can leave quickly in the same marked common space on the West side of rink.
- Encourage participants to minimize their time in or around the facility. Remind players to follow physical distancing guidelines when leaving the facility.
- Disinfect helmet, stick and skates after each training session.
