Important Information

- **Player Commitment:** All players & coaches are expected to attend every practice and tournament (excluding school events/medical emergencies). This will require accountability and personal sacrifices. The number of players per team (minimum 10 per Open and National level teams) is based on team needs and positions.
- **Playing Time:** All teams at NORCO are managed with **team goals** being the top priority. Playing time will be determined by positions, hard work, performance, attitude and team needs. Coaches are committed to improving player's skills to compete for playing time while also supporting team goals. Our younger teams (13 Blue and under) are predominately geared towards equal playing time.
- **Tournament Requirements:** All mandated out of state travel will require players to fulfill Stay & Play policy. Player air/hotel and personal food are the responsibility of parents and are NOT included in membership fees. Tournament entry fee and staff expenses/pay are included. Transportation to all tournaments is the responsibility of families. Players need to arrive by 6:00pm the night before the tournament and cannot make plans to depart before 6:00pm on the last day of the tournament. All Tournament entry fees are non-refundable regardless of participation or acceptance.
- **Postseason:** Postseason tournament fees are included in the cost for 18 Black. NOT included in fees: player transportation, housing, or personal food. If 18 Blue qualifies or receives an at large bid, they will be required to attend at an additional cost to cover tournament entry fees, staff & additional training.
- *A team if accepted for Nationals WILL attend Nationals. Otherwise, admin will make a final decision on a postseason tournament team will attend if possible.
- **Membership fees include:** Facility fees, use of equipment, staff and administration salaries, staff registrations, staff clinic fees, tournament entry fees (excludes stay & play policy), local tournaments, training, coaches travel (if required), competition uniforms and practice gear.
