2. The student-athlete must be in good standing with their graduating high school and soccer club.
3. The student-athlete further agrees to follow all rules for participation of the sport as determined by the coaching staff.
4. The student shall obey all school, local and provincial laws.
5. Participation in a sport other than the scholarship sport is at the discretion of the head coach of the scholarship sport.
