

# Stillwater Area Hockey Association Waiver and Tryout Illness/Injury Policy

SAHA has an Association-wide waiver policy and tryout injury/illness policy. The Stillwater Area Hockey Association board reserves the right to vote upon all waiver situations. In extraordinary situations the board reserves the right to make exceptions.

Waiver Scenario	Minnesota Hockey Policy	SAHA Policy
A player <b>lives in Stillwater</b> School District 834, <b>may or may not attend</b> a Stillwater Area School, and <b>waivers out of SAHA or plays outside of SAHA, but now wants to come back.</b>	If their residence is in the Stillwater School District then they do not need a waiver.	The player is eligible except at the highest division for one year with full eligibility thereafter.
A player <b>does not live</b> in Stillwater School District 834 and <b>open enrolls into the District</b> , but <b>does or does not have a signed waiver</b> from his existing association.	Follow Minnesota Hockey rules.	Follow Minnesota Hockey rules. - The player is eligible except at the highest division for one year with full eligibility thereafter. Exception: players enrolling in 9th grade for the first time are immediately eligible to compete at any division in their association of their school attendance.
A player <b>does not live</b> in Stillwater School District 834, <b>nor attend a District school</b> , but wants to play in SAHA.	Follow Minnesota Hockey rules.	Unless it's an extraordinary situation, SAHA will not waiver in the player. <i>*In extraordinary situations the board reserves the right to make exceptions.</i>
A player <b>lives in Stillwater</b> School District 834, but <b>does not attend</b> a Stillwater District school. They played <b>outside of SAHA last year</b> , but want to <b>play in</b> Stillwater this year.	If their residence is in the Stillwater School District then they do not need a waiver.	The player is eligible except at the highest division for one year with full eligibility thereafter.
A player <b>moves into</b> Stillwater School District 834 and <b>enrolls into the District after tryouts have closed.</b>	Waiver not required.	The player will be placed on a team based upon availability and the discretion of the board, excluding the highest division.
An existing SAHA player is <b>sick or injured and cannot tryout</b> , but will <b>return post-tryouts.</b>		The player will be placed on a team based upon the tryout scores of three like players provided by the previous year coaching staff as well as boys and girls director. <i>*In extraordinary situations the board reserves the right to make exceptions.</i>
