Safety Plan Options

may include but is not limited to

- » Altering training schedules
- » Providing or requiring chaperones
- » Implementing contact limitations
- » Implementing measures prohibiting one-on-one interactions
- » Suspensions from participation in some or all aspects of sport activity

Temporary Measures



The measure is reasonably appropriate based on the seriousness of the allegations and the facts and circumstances of the case



Reasonably appropriate to maintain the safety or well-being of the Claimant, other Athletes, or the sport community or



The allegations against the Respondent are sufficiently serious that the Respondent's continued participation in the sport could be detrimental to the best interest of sport and those who participate in it.

Center does not take jurisdiction, local association will hold a hearing

Outcome

Center takes jurisdiction, may choose to continue temporary measures
