Remember those sounds of preparation in the electric atmosphere near the starting gate? The senses of the young contenders and the coaches and the officials were at a high state of readiness. There was stamping and sliding ski and snowboard surfaces back and forth to ensure a clean running surface. Quiet last minute advice and encouragement; then the countdown and with shouts from friends the competitor disappears.

## **INVESTING IN THE FUTURE OF SNOWSPORTS**

One of the main objectives of **Bogus Basin Ski Club** is to sustain snowsports in order to ensure that the inspirational experience of snowsports will remain for future generations. Our purposes are four-fold:

- (1) To provide financial aid to a junior snowsport competitor.
- (2) To award an athlete who excels at their level.
- (3) To recognize one of our iconic members by naming the scholarship after him, “The Bob Greenwood Snowsports Scholarship.”
- (4) To develop a personal relationship with a junior competitor as outreach with an eye toward building present and future membership with athletes and parents.

### **Steps:**

- **Program Development**
- **Fund Raising**
- **Advertising**
- **Evaluating Applications**
- **Awarding the scholarship**

**Proposal:** We would like to encourage **BBSC** to adopt the four objectives by raising funds to help support a young Bogus Basin athlete to achieve his/her snowsports goals. A scholarship will assist athletes who are committed to pursuing a competitive Alpine snowsports program. Scholarship funds may be used to ***offset training expenses and competition entrance fees, but may not be used for personal travel or equipment.*** Financial aid is made to the teams on which they compete, not to individuals.

**Criteria:** We are developing the criteria used to award the scholarship based on achievement in alpine snowsports and academics as well as the applicant’s goals and financial need. Community involvement will also be considered.

**Bogus Basin Ski Club Selection Committee:** One **Bogus Basin** ski coach, one **BBSC Board** member, one representative of **Bogus Basin Ski Education Foundation** and two others still TBD (College of Idaho coach, other **BBSC** member, etc.) This committee will choose the scholarship recipient.

Applications for the scholarship are due digitally by **December 03, 2021**. Scholarships will be awarded in **January 2022**, by the **BBSC Selection Committee**.

We would like to make our scholarship selection with an eye toward expectations of the long-term contributions that the student athlete may make to the snowsports community and the larger community as well.

The scholarship honoree would be expected to forerun one of the Bogus Basin Wednesday night races and also speak briefly to our membership at our annual meeting (usually held in April) about their snowsports competition activities and goals, as well as how this scholarship helped them.



# BBSC Scholarship Application Guide



**Completed applications are due to the Bogus Basin Ski Club Selection Committee. A complete application includes:**

1. The Application Form: This is a downloadable PDF file. Both the applicant and a parent/guardian must sign the Application Form.
2. **Biographical Sketch** to include:
  - a. What are your favorite school subjects? How do you combine your education goals with snowsports competition? What is your Grade Point Average (GPA)?
  - b. In what other sports, activities or hobbies do you participate?
  - c. What is it about snowsports competition that excites you?
  - d. What is your favorite training situation? How many days per month do you train?
  - e. What are your snowsports competition objectives for the next year?
  - f. What does sportsmanship mean to you?
  - g. How do you give back to snowsports competition now, and how do you plan to continue to give back to snowsports competition in the future?
  - h. Tell us of your accomplishments and/or special awards you have received.
3. **United States Ski & Snowboard Association Athlete History Viewer** for the past two seasons. This document is available from the United States Ski & Snowboard Association website, <https://usskiandsnowboard.org>. Please provide this information if you have competed as a United States Ski & Snowboard Association athlete in the past.
4. **Letters of Recommendation:** A minimum of two is required, but a third may also be submitted. One letter should be from the athlete's club or coach. The other letters are important too, as they may provide supporting documentation for an athlete's involvement in their community or bring emphasis to something the athlete deems important. Letters of Recommendation from a parent will not be considered because what parent would not recommend their son or daughter for a scholarship?
5. **Photos:** A photo of the applicant (head shot or head and shoulders only) should be submitted in a digital format (JPG, JPEG, PNG, TIFF, GIF, or HEIC). Successful applicants will also be asked to provide this photo, along with a competition photo in digital photo format to be used for possible publication.

**Completed digital application must arrive no later than December 3, 2021.**

Applications and the information therein is for the exclusive use of the **BBSC Selection Committee** only and will not be used for any purpose other than the award of scholarships, except as noted above. All application documents need to be submitted electronically via email to: [bbscscholarship@bogusbasinskiclub.org](mailto:bbscscholarship@bogusbasinskiclub.org) . The applicant also needs to make this email address available to those individuals from whom they request letters of recommendation so that the letters may be sent directly to the selection committee.

**Applications will be reviewed and scholarships awarded in January 2022.**

Funds for successful applicants shall be deposited to the athlete's team/club and used to offset costs, as detailed above. It will be the responsibility of the team/club administrator to determine the proper application of the funds, as requested by the athlete.
