1.0 OVERVIEW

This policy will govern the procedure of when and how the Executive Committee (EC) will cancel practices, games, and events for teams affected by the Covid-19 virus.

2.0 POLICY

2.1 Any coaching staff or player on an AMHA team must review the latest version of the Alberta Government Covid-19 Daily Screening Checklist before attending any AMHA events.

2.1.1 If a coaching staff or player answers “Yes” to any of the questions they must follow the guidelines in the document and NOT attend the event.

2.1.2 If a coaching staff or player answers “No” to all the questions they are able to attend the AMHA event.

2.2 Any coaching staff or player on an AMHA team that has a confirmed positive test for Covid-19 must inform the AMHA Staff of the positive test, as soon as possible. All information will be kept confidential, with the team being notified to take the necessary steps and self-isolate as per the Alberta Health Services (AHS) legal requirements.

2.2.1 If a coach or player knowingly has a confirmed positive test for Covid-19 or has knowingly been exposed to a confirmed positive test of a Covid-19 individual and still comes to an AMHA event, they could be subject to disciplinary actions.

2.3 Once AMHA is made aware of the individual with the positive Covid-19 test they will determine if any action has to be taken.

2.3.1 Confirmed case where the individual has been in close contact with the team will result in the immediate cancellation of all AMHA team activities, including practices, dryland, games and events. The team activities will remain stopped until AHS Contact Tracing lets AMHA know the team is clear to participate again or 14 days, whichever occurs first.

2.3.2 Confirmed case where the individual has not been in close contact with the team will only result in that individual being not allowed to attend all AMHA team activities, including practices, dryland, games and events until cleared to return by AHS Contact Tracing.

- 2.4 If a Coach is a member of more than one AMHA team and one of the team's activities are cancelled due to a positive Covid-19 test then that coach must NOT coach on their other team until cleared to participate by AHS.
- 2.5 If a player has been told to self-isolate by AHS, they must not attend any AMHA activities until cleared to do so from AHS.
