JOB TITLE – SCOREKEEPER TEAM MEMBER POSITION LENGTH & HOURS-

The Game Staff is a 4-month contract position which would automatically renew for the next season. This individual will be expected to fulfill the requirements of the position throughout the term of FALL (September - November) or WINTER (December- February) or SPRING (March-June) or SUMMER (July- August). This is an un-paid position for approximately 2-6 hours per week.

POSITION OVERVIEW – The Game Staff Member is responsible for helping the operation of our basketball programs including scorekeeping and shot clock operation of BWT's Youth games. Reporting to the Program Coordinator, the successful candidate will be responsible for, but not limited to:

- Setup of the basketball site at each gym as required including but not limited to floor preparation, equipment setup, handout of promotional materials and ensure the safety of all participants
- Preparation of the game scoresheets, statsheets, photography and/or video equipment
- Communicate with the referees, players and spectators and provide excellent customer service
- Complete administrative duties at site (scorekeep)
- Help with the development, distribution and promotion of events and related marketing materials.
- Respond to player inquires about up and coming programs and special BWT added value offers
- Complete the program including wrap of equipment, summary of sheets and preparation for next event
