COVID-19 Protocols – Updated 2-19-2021

In adherence with State and Local government mandates and in order to provide the best possible experience KCIC is enacting the following protocols.

1. **All persons are required to wear masks at all times during their entire visit at KCIC.**
2. All coaches and off-ice officials are required to wear masks while on the bench or in the penalty box area. Players may remove masks when going onto the ice for their game.
3. Players should arrive at the rink no more than 30 minutes before the start of on-ice activities. Anyone arriving 30 minutes before their start time should wait outside of the facility and be socially distanced from others.
4. At the scorers/announcers box, best practice would be that one assigned adult will be responsible for clock and scorebook with nobody else allowed in that area. Masks should be worn by off ice officials at all times.
5. Check In and Tracking Protocol will continue with external temperature taken of each individual upon arrival. Any individual with an external temperature reading exceeding 100.4 F will not be allowed in the facility.
6. No spectator limits as of 2-19-2021.
7. Spectators and participants are required to exit the arena in a timely manner. Spectators may wait for the team outside or in their vehicle. There will be no “hanging out” in the arena lobby.
8. Players/Skaters participating in on-ice activities will be sent to assigned areas to prepare for the event. Please come as fully dressed as possible as KCIC will use some common areas like lobby and benches in the arena to finish preparing. When assigned to a locker room, players must continue to wear their mask as they prepare for on-ice activity.
9. Spectators are asked to sit on the labeled “sit here” areas in the stands.
10. Staff will be cleaning all lobby seats, stands, and locker rooms at the end of each session.
11. Absolutely no dogs will be allowed at KCIC (Service Dogs are welcome)
