

OTHS BOOSTER CLUB MEETING

November 13, 2024

President Tiffany Ditchfield called the meeting to order with 13 members in attendance. In addition, community member Dan Haas was present.

The meeting began with a proposal from Mr. Haas, owner of Two Rivers Leather, to coordinate with Booster Club and OHS to sell leather wallets with the OHS Pirate logo on them, with the Booster Club/school receiving a portion of the proceeds. Booster Club will follow up if interested.

A motion to approve the minutes from the October 2024 meeting was made by Josh Mammon and seconded by Kim Ruhland. Treasurer Stephanie Larsen could not be present, so the October treasurer's report will be reviewed in December.

Administrative Reports

Athletic Director's Report Mr. Leslie reported that three teams had State appearances:

- Girls' Tennis – Zulee Moreland won sectionals and her first match at State!
- Cross Country – Shalyn Quinn ran at State and finished with a personal best time!
- Boys' Golf – the team won the 2A State Championship!

Meal reimbursement for State participants was requested in the amount of \$250 total.

Winter sports have started. Of note, OHS will host the Dean Riley boys' basketball tournament during Thanksgiving week.

Mr. Leslie provided information on the following potential projects, as discussed at prior meetings:

- Additional cameras for live streaming
 - Baseball/softball – will need a rep to come out and give us a cost estimate
 - Love gym - \$4,000
 - Soccer – between \$1,400 (Pixellot) and \$2,000-3,000 (Hudl)
- Play clocks for football
 - Not recommended – staffing is difficult, they rarely match with the official time, officials don't rely on them, they cause confusion
 - Issues with running electrical inside of the existing track
- Kingman gym balcony railings – not feasible due to existing code complications

Lisa Smithmeyer praised Mr. Leslie for keeping fans/followers informed of the scores/outcomes of various OHS sports contests via the OHS Athletics Facebook Page. It has been great to be able to follow along from home!
