

## 2025 TGHSLL Annual League Meeting

The annual League meeting was held on December 11, 2025. Lewis Wright (President) called the meeting to order. Roll call was done and a quorum was established. Lewis asked if there were any new members and there was no response. Lewis turned the meeting over to Bob Martien (Secretary) to briefly introduce each of the rule change proposals brought forward for discussion and agreement to bring to voting.

Proposal 1) 2/3 voting by district members to remove their district coordinator.

Proposal was tabled and not brought to vote. A few members took issue with how the proposal was modified by removing Board members from the 2/3 removal voting. It was pointed out the League bylaws do not give authority to district members to remove Board of Director members.

Proposal 2) Players must be rostered by Jan 15 to play elsewhere if rostering team folds

Much discussion regarding rostering versus registering. Concerns were expressed by some members regarding protection of players. Agreed to modify the proposal by changing from rostering to registration and clarified this applies to incoming freshmen as well as returning players. Brought forward for voting.

Proposal 3) JV players can play in regular season non-counter varsity interdivisional games without counting toward the 3 game restriction in the current rules

Proposal agreed to and brought forward for voting. Discussion regarding the need to track JV players playing in varsity games to ensure the rules are met. No solution was proposed.

Proposal 4) Playoff structure/hosting sites/USAL oversight of district coordinator voting

After discussion it was agreed to break this proposal into 4 separate proposals for voting

- 1) Oversight by USAL for district member voting on new district coordinators
- 2) Change super regional weekend from week before State championship to 2 weeks before State championship
- 3) Hosting site rotation for super regionals (seeding is not changed)
- 4) State championship hosting district must have all three divisions in the district to be able to host

Proposal 5) Suspension of a member if lawsuit file filed against other members including Board of Directors and district coordinators

Proposal was tabled and not brought forward for voting.

Proposal 6) Post season award process

Proposal was tabled and not brought forward for voting. There was discussion and agreement on the need for programs to enter statistics to support post season awards.

A few members expressed their views on the need to modify and/or reconsider some of the tabled proposals for future action.

Lewis announced Scott Yurashek (North District Coordinator) is now League President, the referee contract is being worked on, and an 'affiliation' survey will be done in 2026 with public school members (data gathering only in 2026). Financials were not covered due to the meeting running long (December 2025 financial statement is attached)

Lewis then moved the meeting be adjourned due to the meeting running late (2+ hours at this point). Proposal was seconded and there were no objections. Meeting was adjourned.

Voting by Survey Monkey was done through Monday 8 pm December 15, 2025. 52 members voted. Results are summarized as follows (voting results are attached):

JV players can play in interdivisional varsity games without restriction - passed

Move super regional date to two weeks before State championship – failed

Super regional hosting site rotations – passed

Hosting district must have all three Divisions to be eligible to host State championship - passed

Removal of USAL oversight for district coordinator voting – passed

Player registration by Jan 15 – passed
