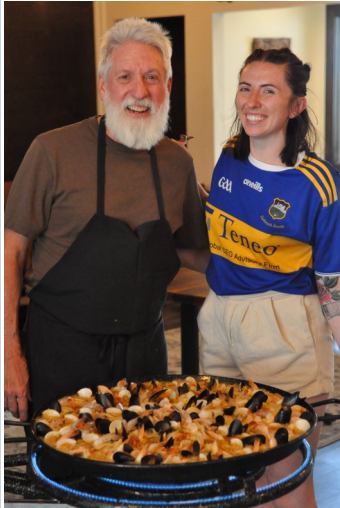

## Notes from Your Ski Patrol

### Before the Snow Falls

Although it's still summer in the valley, it's time for the ski patrol to start our yearly training. We start with online courses, then move into the classrooms. After that we spend days on the mountain training outdoor patient care and treatment, new and most advanced equipment for patient safety and comfort, sled control, triage for a mass incident, helicopter rescue requirements and chairlift evacuation, just to name a few. We also retrain CPR every year following the American Heart Association guidelines.

Each year we also have a candidate class that spends several weeks online and in the classroom. Then they train in the snow for several weeks learning outdoor patient care and toboggan handling before they can graduate to rookie status. Our goal is to meet the needs of every patient and treat them with our medical training as well as dignity and respect.
