- **I will learn and understand the rules of the game as appropriate for my age and competition level.**
- **I will make every attempt to be on time and ready to play for all games and practices, and to always give my best.**
- **I will positively support my teammates. I will acknowledge and applaud their efforts.**
- **I agree to play and abide by the rules of the game.**
- **I will positively represent Spring-Ford Youth Basketball on and off the court.**
- **I will play in a safe and positive manner. Violence, bullying, and any abuse of any nature will not be tolerated, including any threatening behavior.**
