2017/2018 School Year - Dec 2017-May 2018

- **Terra Linda Elementary – West Jordan**
 - 581 students
 - 11 during school visits to allow us to work with every class, student and teacher
 - Visits in Winter & Spring
 - Sessions ran with students from ages 5-13
 - Able to integrate the Special Behavior students into sessions with their peers.

- **Entheos Academy - Kearns**
 - 577 students
 - 4 during school visits to allow us to work with every class, student and teacher.
 - Visits in Winter
 - Sessions ran with students from ages 5-13
 - Were also able to work in their after-school program

- **Majestic Elementary – West Jordan**
 - Title 1 School
 - 264 students
 - 7 during school visits to allow us to work with every class, student and teacher.
 - Visits in Winter & Spring
 - Sessions ran with students from ages 5-13
 - This school has a PE specialist, Callie Collyer, we were able to work with her and train her in the delivery of sessions during our visits. We shared some of our sessions with her to allow her to continue implementing successful soccer sessions until we return.

- **Oakwood Elementary – Holladay**
 - 485 students
 - 6 during school visits to allow us to work with every class, student and teacher.
 - Visits in Winter
 - Sessions ran with students from ages 5-13
 - Able to deliver sessions to their two Special Behavior classes eventually integrating some of the students with their peers.

- **Silver Crest Elementary – Herriman**
 - 940 students
 - 3 Full-Day during school visits to allow us to work with every class, student and teacher.
 - Visits in Spring
 - Sessions ran with students from ages 5-13

- **Entheos Academy – Magna**
 - 577 students
 - 4 during school visits to allow us to work with every class, student and teacher.
 - Visits in Spring
 - Sessions ran with students from ages 5-13

- **Bingham High School – South Jordan**

 - This year the school now has a PE specialist, Lindsey Curtis, and we have been working with her and training her in the delivery of sessions during our visits. We will be sharing some of our sessions with her to allow her to continue implementing successful soccer sessions until we return.
 - We worked very closely with the Principal, Karen Gorringer, in helping her to purchase 8 goals for her school and students to use during school which is building up the sport within her school’s community.
 - On Sept. 4, we hosted a motivational assembly for the school where we brought in Professional EPL player, James Milner, to speak with the students, teachers and faculty about what it takes to be successful, persevere and attack life with grit and determination.
 - On Sept. 20, we attended the school’s Family Fall Festival evening event where we hosted their outdoor activity by conducting a soccer clinic for all the students, siblings and parents in attendance (some parents actually participated in the sessions 😊). We ran a total of fourteen 20 min sessions for the event.
 - On Oct. 12, we were able to assist the school to successfully execute an emergency evacuation drill to our Indoor Facility. Through this great Relationship/Partnership with the school the club is providing our Indoor Facility as an emergency evacuation site for Terra Linda.
 - On Oct. 31, we ran a session for the school as part of their feature for Fox 13’s ‘Cool School of the Week’ event. The Principal, Karen, asked us to be a part of this as she believes we are a big part of what makes her school cool.
