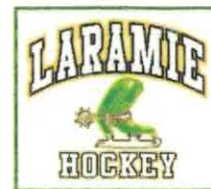

2018-2019 Summary Report

Thank you for being a part of the Outlaw hockey community! We are grateful to have your skater(s) participate in the great sport of hockey with our club. The 2018-2019 season has come to a close and we would like to take this opportunity to share with you some of the outcomes, successes, and future directions for the LAHC.

Team Play: We had 145 skaters registered with the club this year. We again fielded two 10U and 12U teams. To put these numbers in perspective, from 2006-2013 the club had fewer than 100 registered players. All of our age levels fielded "A" level teams. Our U14 team went undefeated during the regular season at the "A" level. Four Laramie players were named to Wyoming Amateur Hockey League (WAHL) A-Division All State Teams. The 19U Girls All-state A-team selections included **Gabrielle Schwindt** for defense, **Cassie Troy** as goalie and **Emmie Wahlgren** as offense. In addition, Laramie's **Yvonne Durfee won the Girls 19U state Fastest Skater Competition**. LHS senior **Evan Naughton** was honored with selection to the 18U High School All-state A-team for offense at ceremonies Saturday March 2 in Gillette, Wyoming. Evan is the first LAHC U18 player to be All-State in the "A" Division. We also had numerous players participate in Team Wyoming and the Wyoming Cutthroats programs. Volunteers: The Laramie hockey club is a volunteer organization, and we have a lot to be thankful for in terms of volunteerism. We had almost 60 volunteers, coaches, managers, and board members this past season, to whom we are in debt for their commitment to youth hockey.

Finances: Financially, the club remains sound. A fiscal year summary of the club finances will be posted on our website after the end of our fiscal year on May 31st. We await a financial review from ACM Accounting Services. We should have that any day and that will also be shared with the club once we receive it. Remember we have had some big changes to the club's annual budget over the past few years: (1) we have added a month of practice time; (2) we have gone from fielding 5 teams to 7; (3) ice fees have steadily risen; and (3) WAHL increased the number of games from 16 to 20. We continue seeking sponsorships, are working with the Ice & Event Center on creative ad placements. We hope to add to our outstanding list of corporate supporters to ensure that the club remains on sound financial footing and that hockey remains affordable.
