MEGA And TOA Tournament points will only be allowed 1 per tournament and in the age group wrestler will participate for kids state.

Questions and Clarifications Needed:

For Mega Tournaments, wrestler may wrestle 2 weight classes at state age. Highest placement counts. If they wrestle up in age, it does not count for points.

Wrestler must actively wrestle to accumulate points (no points will be awarded for being only person in bracket; must actually wrestle a match).

Georgia State Champ/Placers only, out of state move ins do not accrue points from their non-Georgia state championship.

Separate top 4

Tie breaker for same amount of points will be determined by placement at highest level tournament. If still tied, coin toss will determine tie breaker.

We are NOT seeding Girls State.

State: Place up to 6th Place, using seeding/separation based on the points above.
