We are excited to have your child join CP T-Ball! Here is some important information to help you and your child get started.



Snack Duty

Each game, one family volunteers to bring snacks and drinks for the team. Please take into account any food allergies within your team.



Team Parent & Dugout Duty

We rely on a team parent to help manage the dugout during games. This role includes keeping the kids organized, helping them get ready to bat, and ensuring everyone is safe and having fun. If you are interested in volunteering as a team parent, please let the coach know.



Equipment

Each player will need to have the following equipment for every game:

- **Glove:** Make sure it fits your child's hand comfortably.
- **Cleats:** Proper footwear is important for safety and performance.
- **Water Bottle:** Staying hydrated is crucial.
- **Hat and Shirt:** These will be provided by the park.
- **Bat:** Should be a USA T-Ball bat, USSSA not permitted.
- **Batting Helmet**



Positive Behavior

We want T-Ball to be a fun and positive experience for everyone involved. Please follow these guidelines:

- **No Yelling:** Encouragement is key. Avoid yelling at the children, coaches, or other guests. Positive reinforcement helps build confidence and enjoyment.
- **Respect:** Show respect for all players, coaches, officials, and other families. Good sportsmanship is a priority.
