A motion to approve the minutes from the September 2024 meeting was made by Courtnye Miller and seconded by Mary Jo Araujo. The September treasurer's report was reviewed. A motion to approve the report was made by Carrie Price and seconded by Ellen Gross.

Administrative Reports

Pirate's Chest Raffle (Courtnye Miller) Sold \$19,130. Gave away \$8,000, of which \$7,150 was donated. Winners were drawn at the Homecoming game on October 4, and checks have all gone out. There were only minor expenses. Overall, this was a successful fundraiser.

Spiritwear (Tiffany Ditchfield) Sales have been good. There are still a number of Homecoming T-shirts available. There will be a Christmas sale during basketball season, as in past years.

Football 50/50 (Stephanie Larsen) Volunteers are ready to go for the last home game. Will be seeking volunteers for basketball season next.

Athletic Director's Report Mr. Leslie introduced LP Co-Op swim coach Rob McNally. Coach McNally requested funding for new warm up suits for the Boys Swim Team. The current warm ups are 11 years old. LP has agreed to pay ½ the cost (\$840), and the program is requesting the other half from Ottawa. A motion was made by Mary Jo Araujo and seconded by Ellen Gross to fund the request for \$840. The motion passed.

Mr. Leslie noted that the boys golf team qualified for the State finals, to be played October 18 & 19. Also upcoming are regionals and sectionals for boys soccer, volleyball, cross country, and girls tennis.

Booster Club made \$2,764 from the concession stand during the Wolfpack games at OHS in September.
