Recap of 2019-2020 Season, Eric Gee ran through the 2019-2020 season, Discussion on the fitness assessment and how do we get more athletes involved. Darlene spoke of its importance and the requirement. Ron spoke about having more locations and times in fall. Steve said to watch be sensitive to the mountain bike fall schedule. Sydney asked Patrick if clubs can still do testing and Patrick said yes. Kayleigh asked about any access to online workout. Ron said his club is working on some training videos. Ron spoke about the Granite Peak race; he hopes to run the event again. Patrick spoke about getting race fact sheets out and try to follow the FIS schedule (30 days prior to the event). Scott said we need to get the information published sooner (this is something we need to discuss at the fall meeting). Get better organized at our events. Mike Morris brought up the same concerns as Patrick. Finished talking through the season's events. Steve & Darlene talked about Lacrosse FIS race and wanted to thank the Rocky athletes for all their help. Sydney spoke about the Tyrol Duals Race.

Updates from CASC

Ron spoke from the coach's perspective. Meetings were useful the night before. The virtual format for the coach's summit was very good.



Patrick, spoke from a Central Division perspective. Speed suit rule up to the division, U12 one ski rule passed and was further clarified. Possibly add skier cross to the alpine program. A committee is being formed to discuss this further. 1-3rd FIS athletes it is recommended that they only have 25 race starts. Seeding U16 at R/C Championships (this was tabled for more discussion and possibly change the FIS age to 15). U14 Vail will be the champions and U16 will most likely be at Steamboat. He hopes to have a draft calendar in about 2 weeks.

Darlene, spoke about the FIS issues and the age issues topic. Hope to have new information by fall 2020. FIS coached need to have level 100. She will try to come in if we want her to.

John discussed site selection about where the Hosking will be held. He described the process and thanked Lacrosse and Indianhead for their bids. The 2021 process was awarded to Marquette Mt.

CR2 Finances

Eric gave an update, CR2 \$34,000.00+/- bank balance. Our books are still open. He spoke of the new registration fees and how the new rate is not going to cut it and we have to discuss this at the fall meeting. We may have to make some adjustments in the fall.

Timing equipment is becoming outdated. I recommend we wait one more year. Current quote is \$10,600.00 for new timing. Scott Bence made a motion to postpone the purchase. The board decided the motion was not needed. The board agreed to wait on the purchase.

CR2 Equipment

John, overall, we are good on all equipment. The use of 30mill gates has dropped our breakage. Eric stated he has about \$59,000 on the books. John stated it was accurate.

New Business:

- Advanced planning for COVID 19 related issues, Eric spoke of our seasons coming and virtual options. Darlene said those plans are being discussed.*
- Advance Planning for Fitness Assessment and AO clinic, Eric stated we need to work on this over the next few months.*
- Action Items for Committees, Craig discussed sponsorships to try to raise \$5-20K. He hopes to have more information by the fall meeting. Scott spoke about website development and the option of joining efforts and combining the regions into one website. Scott said it is being discussed and researched at this time. Ron said he is going to step down as the coach's chair. Ron asked Eric to appoint Joe May as the coached chair. Steve suggested we find out if any more people. Will also agreed with Steve. Eric asked Ron to send out one more notice to the coaches and find out if there is any other interest and then Eric will appoint someone within 30 days.*
