

2019 CCM MN hockey High Performance Girls 14 Program

Phase 1

March 18th – 31st, 2019

District Trials/Top 30 Selection (Cost \$100 per candidate)

Each MH District (12) will invite a minimum of 40 candidates to participate in the trials to determine the top 30 players. Each candidate will receive 3.5 hours of ice time and a participant jersey.

Players/coaches who have not registered with Minnesota Hockey/USA Hockey will be required to register online with USA Hockey at www.usahockeyregistration.com for insurance purposes.

Phase 2

April 1st – April 12th, 2019

**District Top 30 Skills Sessions
(Cost per player \$150)**

The top 30 players from each district will participate in 10 skills training sessions by the district coaching staff. Each district will receive a maximum of 10 hours of ice as a reimbursable expense for pre-festival training preparation. After the pre-festival preparation twenty players will be selected for each district team. (Team formed by April 12th, 2018).

Phase 3

April 26 – April 28, 2019

**Minnesota Hockey Spring Festival: Amsoil Arena Duluth MN
(Cost per player \$200)**

The spring festival will consist of three pools of four teams. The round robin format will have each team play three games in their pool. 102 Players will be picked after the games to participate in the Summer Development Camp in St. Cloud, MN at the SCSU campus.

Player Evaluation: A team of knowledgeable coaches and scouts will evaluate all participants, consult with team coaches and select the top 120 players for participation in the Reebok Minnesota Hockey High Performance Summer Girls 14 Festival. Alternates selectees will also be chosen by the evaluation team and placed on teams in the event original selectees decline the invitation to participate in the Summer Development Camp. All selectees and alternates are required to watch a Summer Development Camp video on the Minnesota Hockey website. The Development Camp schedule will be posted on the HP 14 webpage at www.minnesotahockey.org.

Phase 4

June 9th – 13th, 2019

**Minnesota Hockey Development Camp, St. Cloud
(Cost per player \$650)**

Expense of this festival is shared equally by the participants and is based on actual cost less grants received from Minnesota Hockey (MH) and USA Hockey.

120 selected players participate in a weeklong training camp at St. Cloud State University. Housing and meals are provided.

Six teams play a round robin schedule of games, attend dry land training sessions, and classroom sessions daily. The staff at the Summer Development Camp will include prominent college and high school coaches teamed with current and former college hockey players to serve as coaches, role models, and counselors for each team.

Player Evaluation: All Development Camp staff members identify and evaluate each player on and off the ice. Nightly staff meetings are held to discuss player performance. Each player will have an evaluation form at the end of camp.
