

How to create a Universal Account on GotSoccer

A universal account will help you keep your getsoccer account's in one area with only one login. This will reduce the amount of passwords and switching back and forth between accounts for coaches, board members and families.

Step1: You should to www.gotsoccer.com login page. The page will have you at member Account.

Step2: Click on the Univeral Account tab
